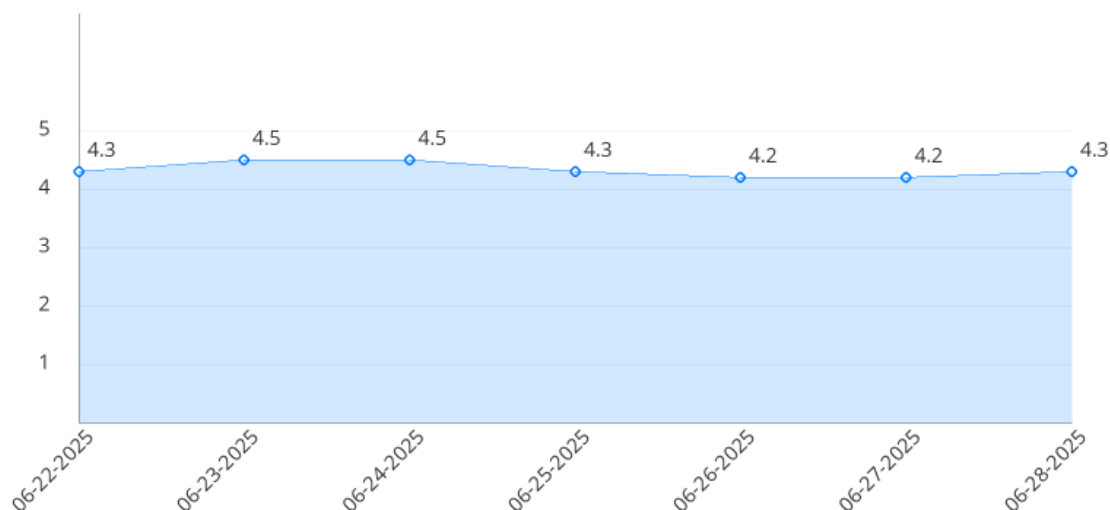

Nuclear War

Score Trend (Week of June 22–28, 2025)



This week, the nuclear threat level has been elevated due to escalating tensions between Israel and Iran, exacerbated by recent US military strikes on Iranian nuclear sites. These actions have increased the risk of nuclear proliferation and potential retaliation, contributing to heightened geopolitical instability in the Middle East. 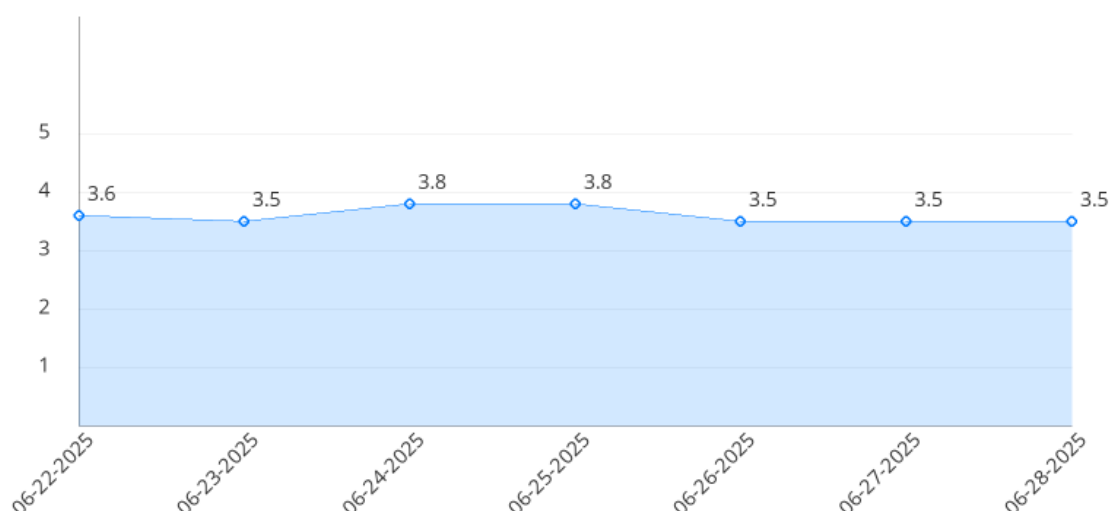

This week, the risk level associated with Artificial Intelligence remains moderate, with a consistent focus on issues of misalignment, potential misuse, and military applications. Concerns are particularly centered around the alignment of AI systems with human values, the risks posed by AI in military contexts, and the broader implications of AI misuse in both immediate and long-term scenarios. The discourse also highlights the need for robust regulatory frameworks to manage these risks and ensure the ethical deployment of AI technologies. Despite the moderate risk score, there is a clear emphasis on advancing AI alignment research and enhancing global cooperation to address these challenges effectively.

- **[Academia]** Conduct interdisciplinary research on AI's societal impacts and alignment challenges to inform policy and ethical guidelines.
- **[Public]** Increase awareness and education on AI risks and safety to foster informed engagement and understanding of AI technologies.

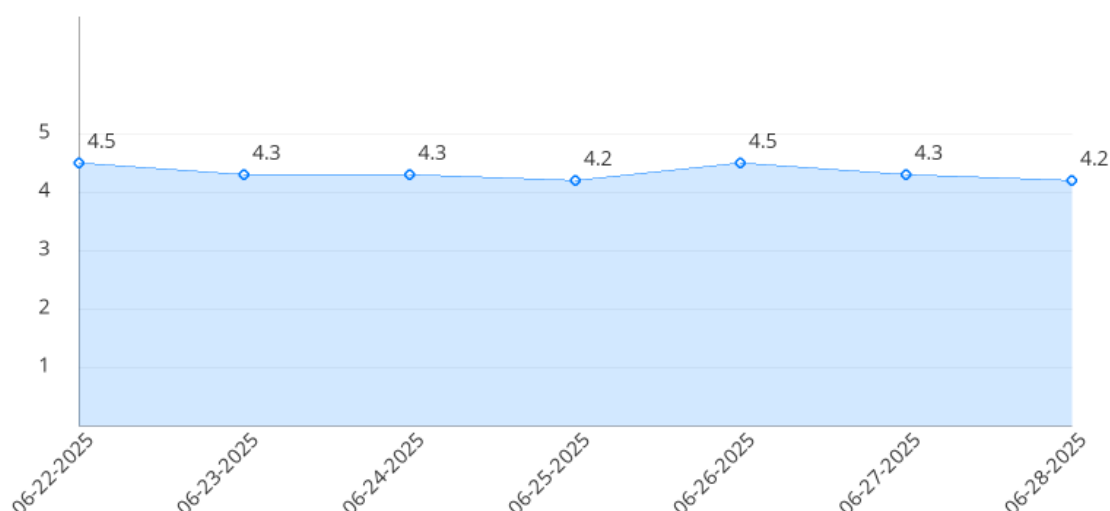

Climate Change

Score Trend (Week of June 22–28, 2025)



This week, the climate risk level remained high, driven by a combination of factors including the imminent breach of the 1.5-degree warming threshold, frequent extreme weather events, and rising greenhouse gas emissions. Overall, the persistent high-risk level underscores the urgency of implementing effective climate action strategies to mitigate these impacts.

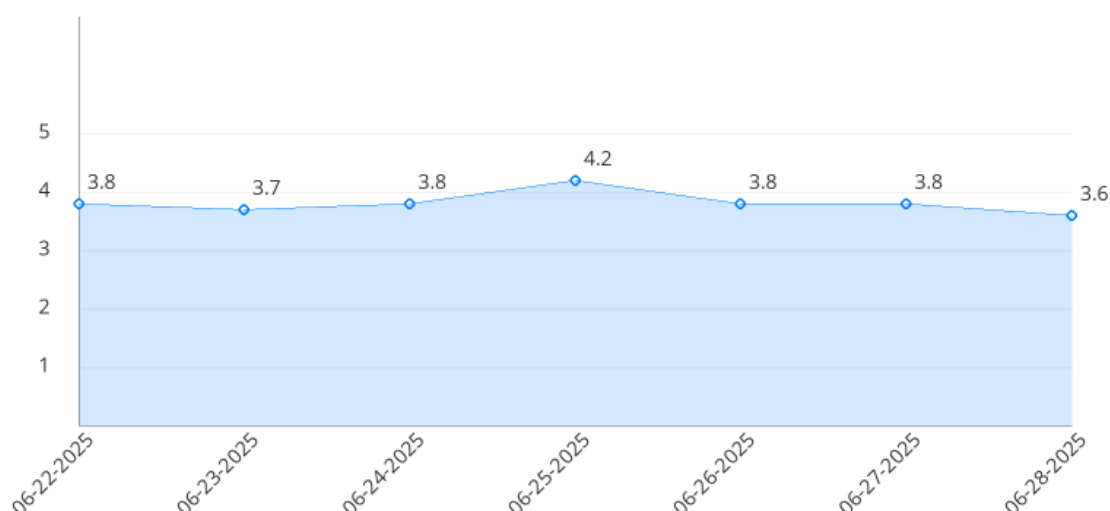

This week, the pandemic risk level fluctuated between moderate and high, primarily due to the emergence of new COVID-19 variants, ongoing avian flu outbreaks, and challenges related to vaccine hesitancy and public health communication. The resurgence of COVID-19 variants and increasing mistrust in vaccines have been significant contributors to the elevated risk levels. Additionally, outbreaks of other infectious diseases, such as MERS and measles, further compounded the situation. Public health leadership and communication challenges, along with misinformation, continue to hinder effective response efforts. The need for enhanced surveillance, communication strategies, and global cooperation remains critical to managing these threats.

- **[Government]** Enhance public health communication strategies to rebuild trust and counter misinformation about vaccines and health advisories.
- **[NGO]** Collaborate with local communities to improve vaccine outreach and address vaccine hesitancy through targeted education campaigns.
- **[Industry]** Accelerate research and development of next-generation vaccines and treatments for emerging infectious diseases.
- **[Healthcare Providers]** Educate patients on the importance of vaccinations and proactively address vaccine hesitancy.
- **[International Organizations]** Strengthen global cooperation and resource sharing to address cross-border health threats like avian flu and MERS.

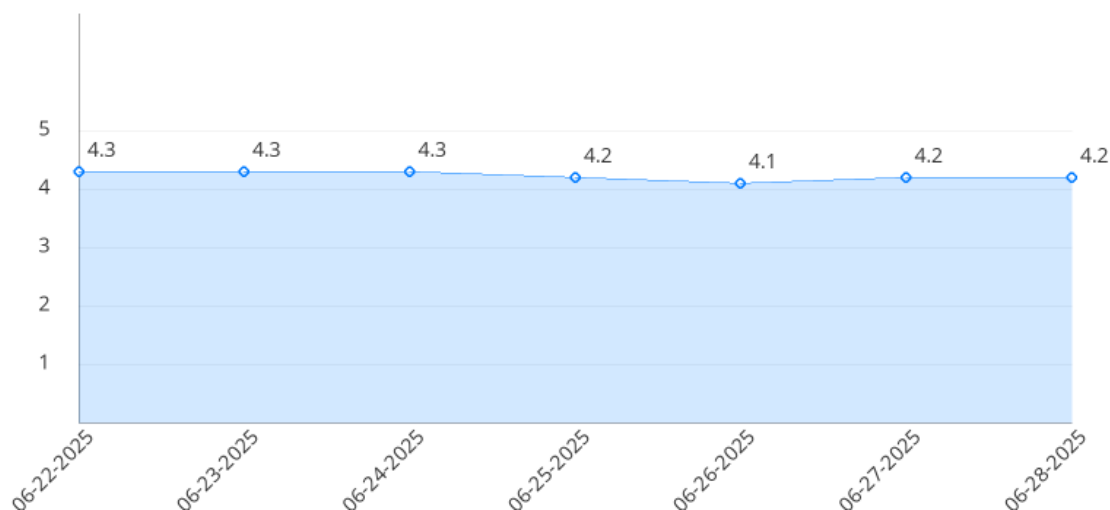

Political disinformation and false narratives around international conflicts, particularly involving US-Iran relations, have been prominent. The exploitation of digital platforms for scams and the dissemination of health and election-related falsehoods continue to exacerbate the situation. Despite slight fluctuations, the overall risk score remains significantly elevated, indicating persistent challenges in maintaining information integrity. The trend underscores the urgent need for enhanced detection mechanisms and international cooperation to counteract these threats effectively.

Recommended Risk Reduction Actions

- **[Government]** Implement stricter regulations and penalties for the dissemination of AI-generated disinformation and deepfakes.
- **[Industry]** Enhance AI and machine learning tools to detect and flag misinformation and deepfakes more effectively on digital platforms.
- **[NGO]** Launch educational campaigns to improve public literacy on identifying and responding to misinformation, focusing on geopolitical and health-related falsehoods.
- **[International Organizations]** Foster cross-border collaborations to monitor and counteract geopolitical disinformation campaigns impacting global security.
- **[Education Sector]** Integrate comprehensive digital literacy programs into school curricula to prepare future generations for navigating complex information environments.

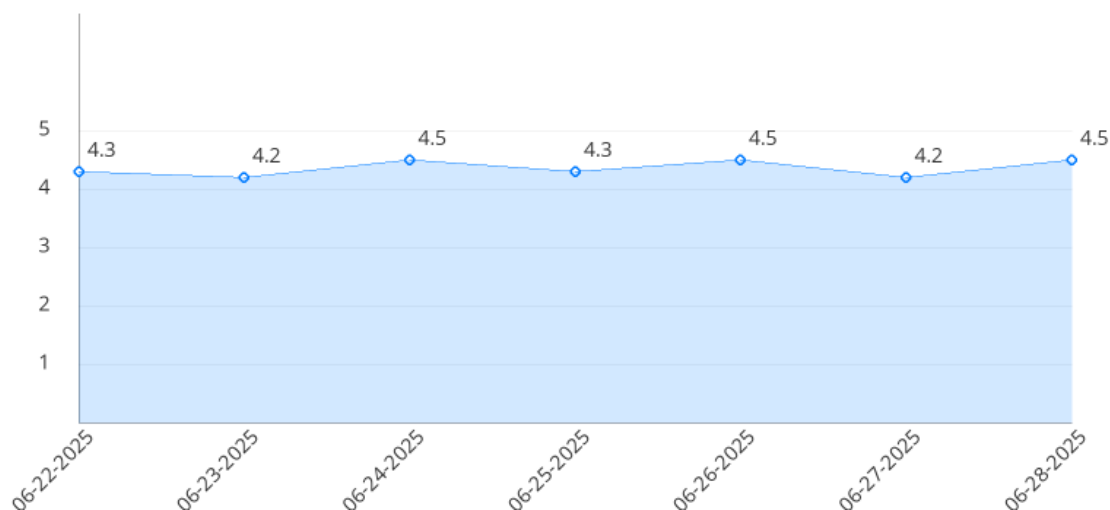
