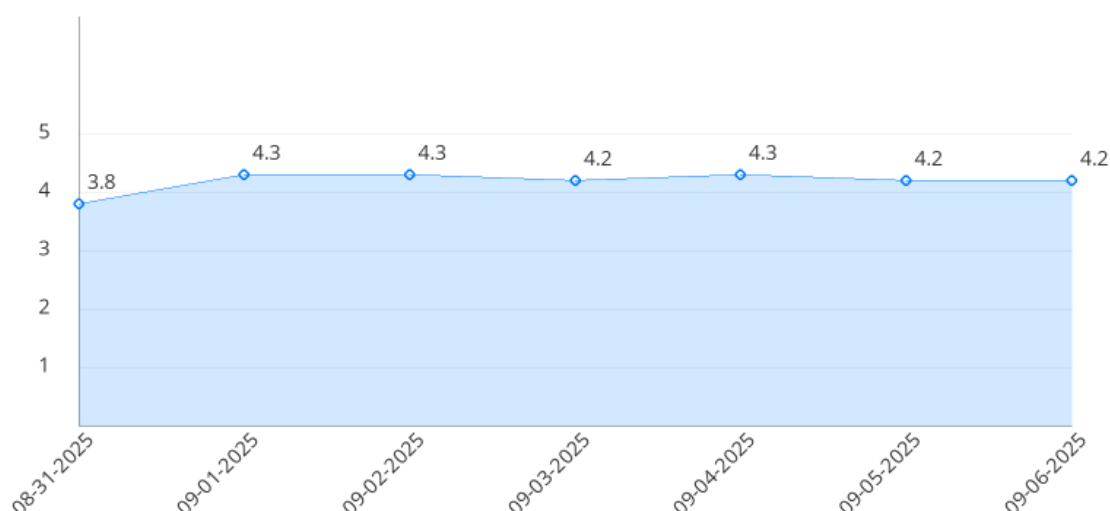

Nuclear War

Score Trend (Week of August 31–6, 2025)



This week, the nuclear threat level has been consistently elevated, with scores ranging from 4.2 to 4.3, primarily due to increased geopolitical tensions, advancements in nuclear technology, and the erosion of arms control treaties. Key factors contributing to this heightened threat include modernization efforts of nuclear arsenals, particularly in North Korea, and the integration of AI into nuclear systems. Additionally, tensions in the Middle East, involving countries like Israel and Iran, have further exacerbated the situation. The lack of effective communication channels among nuclear powers and the deterioration of international arms control agreements have also played significant roles in escalating the threat level.

- **[Industry]** Develop and implement robust cybersecurity measures to protect nuclear command and control systems from potential cyber threats.
- **[International Organizations]** Convene multilateral discussions to strengthen and expand arms control treaties, including emerging nuclear states.
- **[Academia]** Conduct research and develop protocols for the safe integration of AI into nuclear command and control systems to mitigate risks of accidental launches.

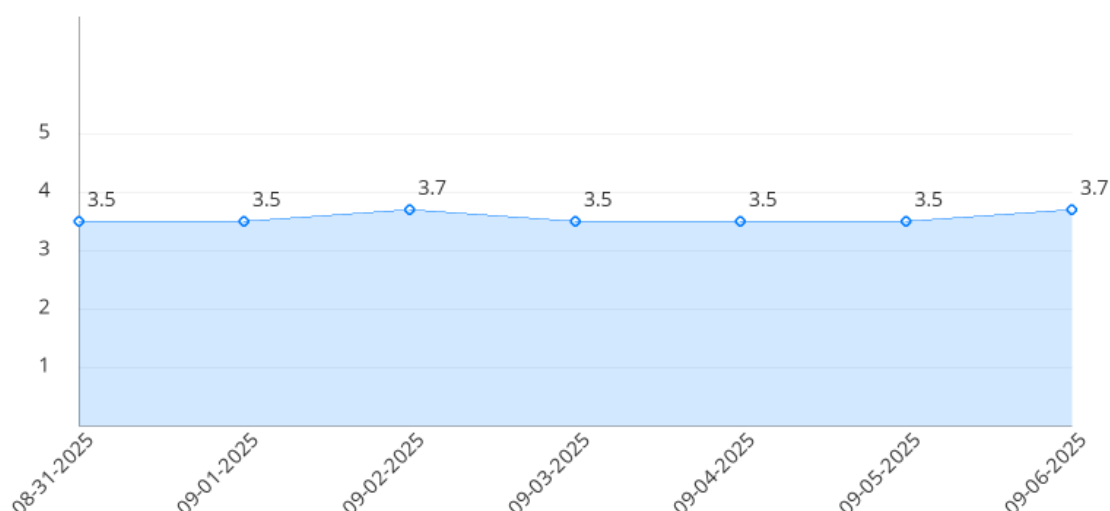

This week, the AI risk level remained moderate, driven by continuous advancements in AI capabilities and persistent concerns about safety, alignment, and regulatory challenges. Efforts to address these challenges include ongoing safety evaluations and discussions around the need for comprehensive regulatory frameworks. There is a focus on ensuring AI systems are aligned with societal values and ethical standards, with calls for transparency and collaboration in AI development. The risk score fluctuated slightly, reflecting the dynamic nature of AI advancements and the associated risks.

- **[Academia]** Conduct interdisciplinary research on AI alignment and safety to better understand and mitigate long-term risks.
- **[International Organizations]** Foster global cooperation on AI safety standards and share best practices to address existential risks.

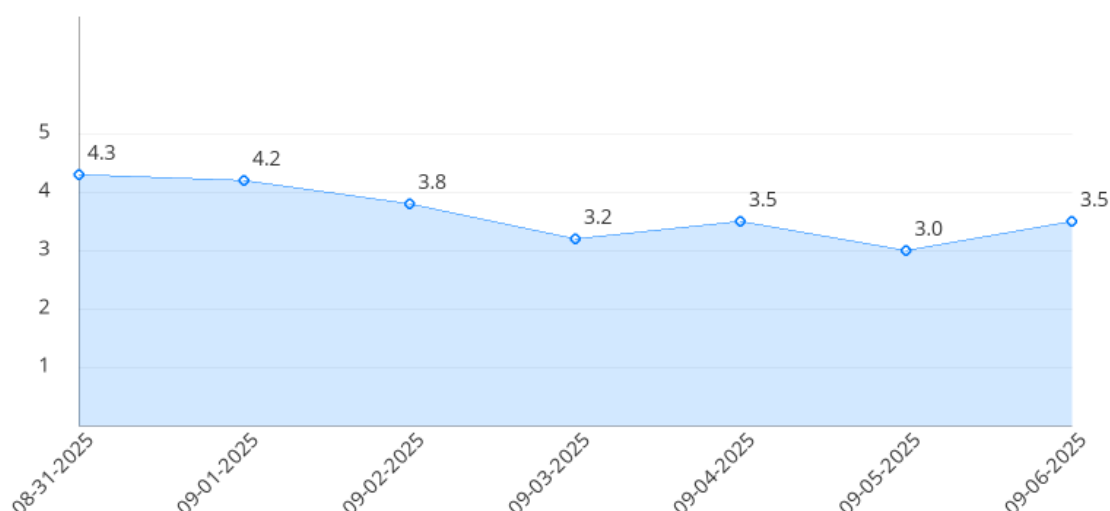
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Climate Change

Score Trend (Week of August 31–6, 2025)

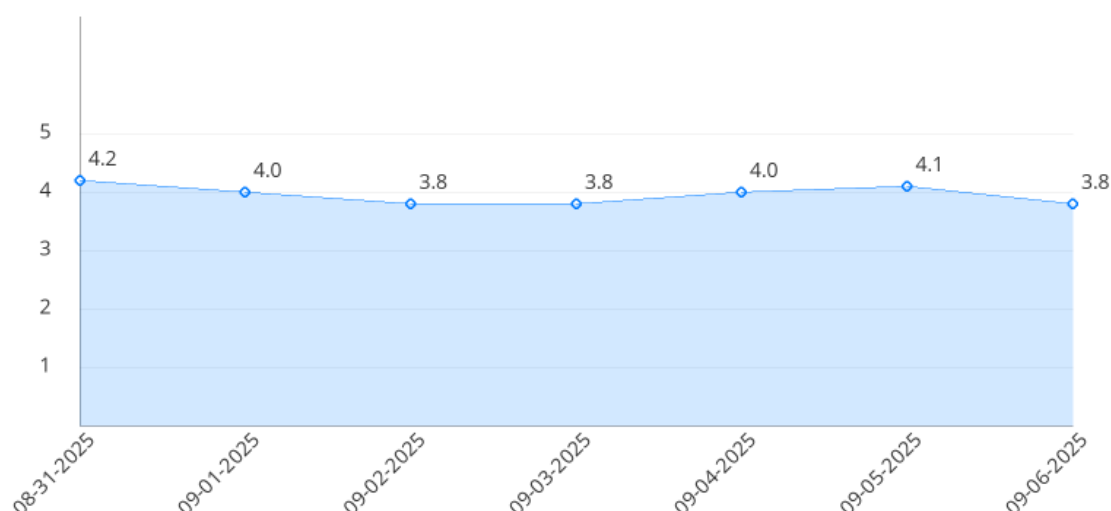

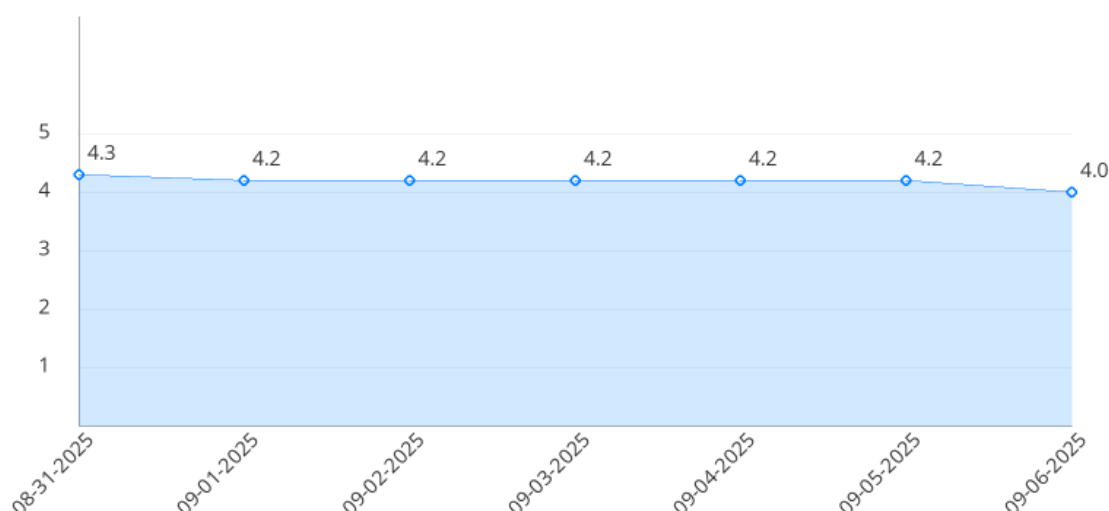

Score Trend (Week of August 31–6, 2025)



This week, the global misinformation risk remains high, with a consistent score around 4.2 to 4.3. The primary drivers include AI-generated deepfakes, political disinformation, and health-related falsehoods, all exacerbated by the dynamics of social media. Prominent figures, such as Donald Trump, have been targeted by deepfake claims, further complicating the landscape. The persistent spread of fake identities and AI-generated content continues to challenge information integrity across various domains, including politics, health, and climate. The situation underscores the need for enhanced detection mechanisms and public awareness initiatives to combat these threats effectively.

Recommended Risk Reduction Actions

- **[Government]** Implement stricter regulations and penalties for the creation and distribution of deepfakes and digital misinformation.
- **[Industry]** Enhance AI and machine learning tools to better detect and flag misleading content, particularly deepfakes and politically charged misinformation.
- **[Education]** Develop and integrate media literacy programs to educate the public on identifying and critically evaluating misinformation.
- **[Tech Companies]** Collaborate to create public awareness campaigns about the dangers and signs of misinformation and disinformation.
- **[Research Institutions]** Conduct studies on the effectiveness of current misinformation countermeasures and develop new strategies to combat emerging threats.

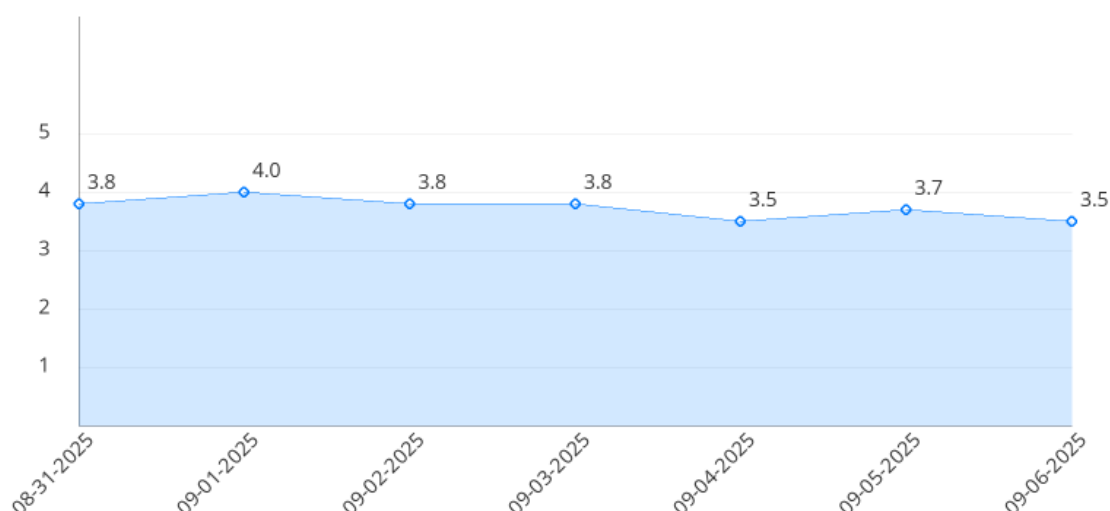

Score Trend (Week of August 31–6, 2025)



This week's trend in 'Unknown / Black Swan' risks highlights several potential threats with unpredictable impacts. The potential eruption of Mount Fuji continues to be a significant concern due to its ability to cause widespread disruption, scoring a high risk level. The UN's declaration of climate change as an existential threat emphasizes the severity of unforeseen global impacts. Additionally, the development of photonic processors for 6G networks presents both opportunities and risks for global communications infrastructure. Thinning Arctic sea ice and its potential to trigger unexpected climatic and geopolitical consequences remain a pressing issue, alongside concerns about the long-term effects of nuclear waste on the environment.
