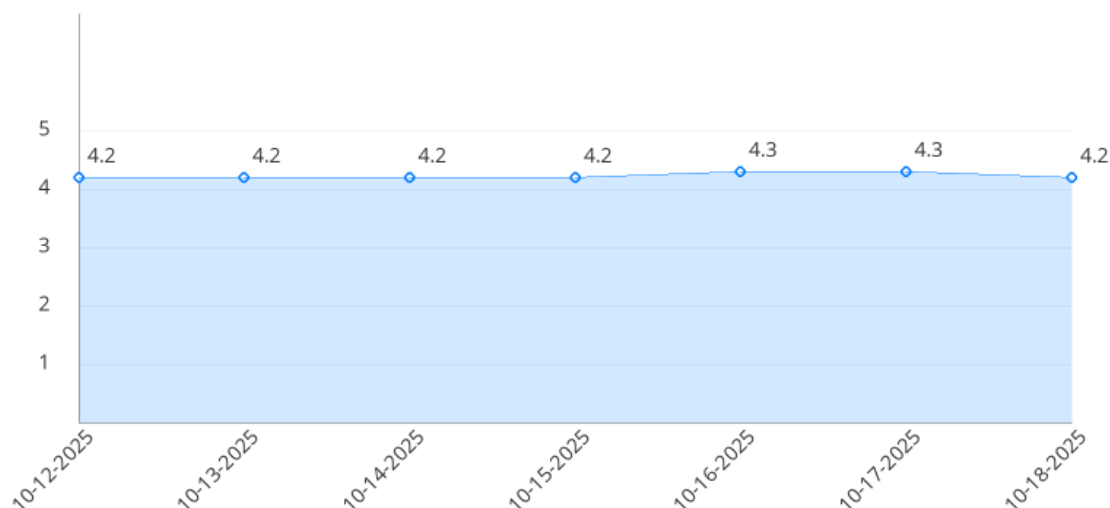

Nuclear War

Score Trend (Week of October 12–18, 2025)



This week, the global nuclear threat level remains elevated due to a combination of factors including the modernization of nuclear arsenals, heightened geopolitical tensions, and a reduction in diplomatic communication channels. Notably, recent escalations in nuclear rhetoric and modernization efforts by countries such as Russia and North Korea have contributed to this increased threat level. Additionally, the integration of AI into nuclear systems and uncertainties surrounding arms control frameworks further exacerbate the situation. The ongoing government shutdowns have also reduced oversight, adding to the complexity of managing nuclear risks effectively.

Recommended Risk Reduction Actions

- **[Government]** Facilitate renewed arms control negotiations to address emerging technologies and modernized arsenals, involving all major nuclear powers.
- **[NGO]** Advocate for public awareness campaigns on the risks of nuclear escalation and the importance of disarmament.
- **[Industry]** Develop and promote technologies that enhance verification and monitoring of nuclear arsenals to ensure compliance with international treaties.
- **[International Organizations]** Convene an emergency summit to address the breakdown of nuclear arms control treaties and establish new frameworks for dialogue.
- **[Military]** Enhance training and protocols for nuclear command and control to prevent unauthorized or accidental launches.

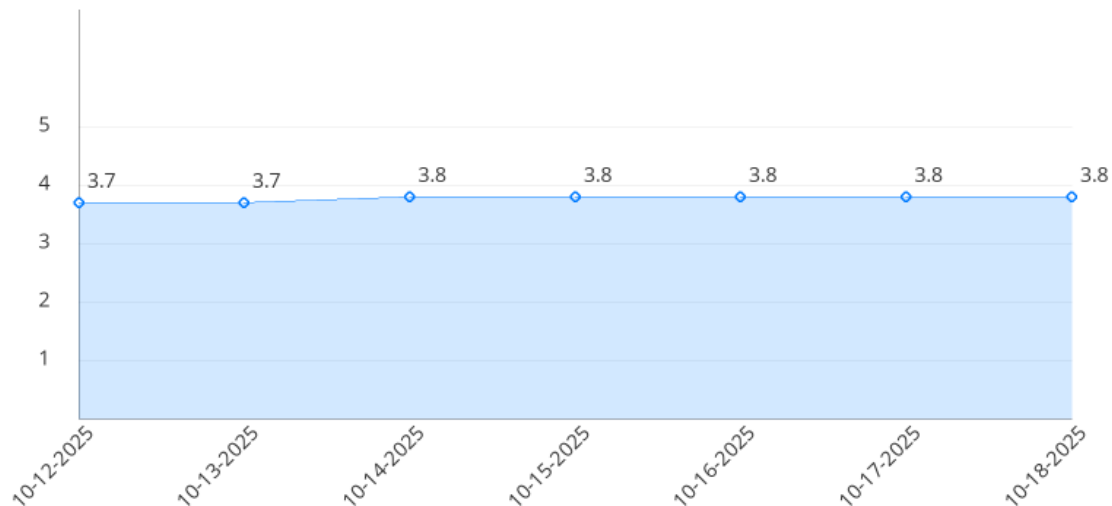

Score Trend (Week of October 12–18, 2025)



This week, the AI risk level has been consistently rated as moderate, with a score of 3.8, due to rapid advancements in AI infrastructure and the formation of strategic partnerships. These developments raise concerns about the concentration of power and potential misuse, particularly in sectors like defense and critical infrastructure.

Legislative actions are being taken to address AI safety, highlighting both the potential for misuse and efforts to mitigate risks. There is a strong emphasis on the need for transparency, accountability, and the development of ethical guidelines to manage AI deployment effectively. The focus remains on ensuring AI technologies are aligned with societal values and do not exacerbate existing inequalities.

Recommended Risk Reduction Actions

- **[Government]** Implement stricter regulations and oversight on AI development and deployment to prevent concentration of power and ensure ethical use.
- **[Industry]** Develop and adhere to industry-wide standards for AI safety and alignment to address potential misuse and existential risks.
- **[NGO]** Advocate for transparency and accountability in AI partnerships and infrastructure projects to mitigate risks of concentration of power.
- **[Academia]** Conduct interdisciplinary research on AI alignment and societal impacts to inform policy and technological development.
- **[International Organizations]** Foster global cooperation to establish unified standards and protocols for AI safety and ethical use.

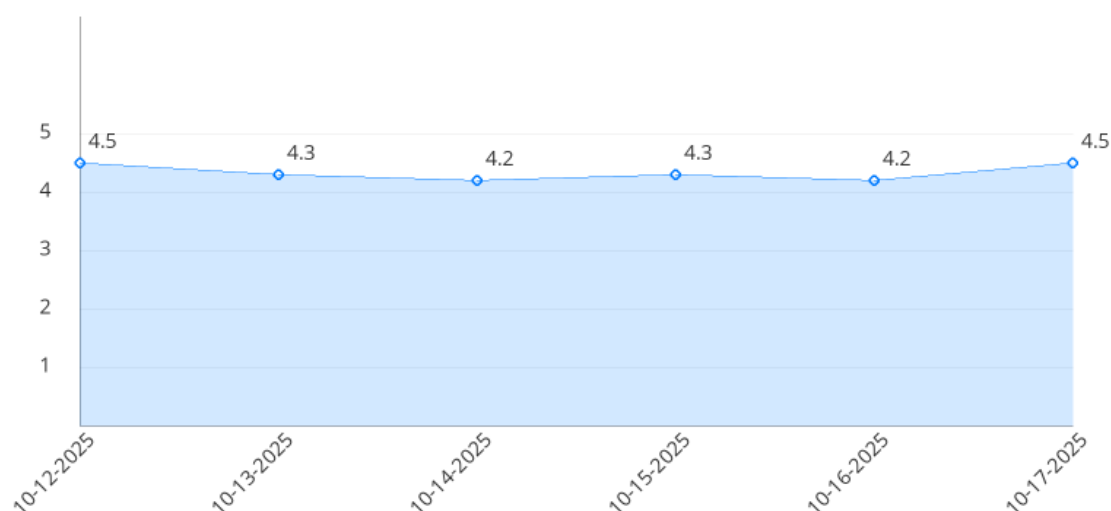

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Climate Change

Score Trend (Week of October 12–18, 2025)



This week, the main trend in climate change highlights a persistently high risk driven by extreme weather events, policy failures, and accelerating feedback loops. Record-breaking temperatures and CO2 levels are exacerbating global warming, with significant threats to ecosystems and inadequate policy responses being recurrent issues. The world is grappling with crossed tipping points and the urgent need for effective climate action is underscored by the increasing frequency and severity of extreme weather events. Despite the recognition of these challenges, global policy responses remain insufficient, necessitating immediate and coordinated efforts to mitigate the impacts of climate change.

Recommended Risk Reduction Actions

- **[Government]** Implement and enforce stricter emissions reduction policies to address greenhouse gas outputs and meet international climate targets.
- **[NGO]** Increase public awareness campaigns to educate communities about the impacts of climate change and promote sustainable practices.
- **[Industry]** Invest in sustainable technologies and practices to reduce carbon footprints and enhance resilience against climate-induced disruptions.
- **[Academia]** Conduct research on climate tipping points and feedback loops to inform policy and response strategies.
- **[International Organizations]** Strengthen global cooperation and funding for climate adaptation and mitigation strategies, focusing on vulnerable regions and ecosystems.

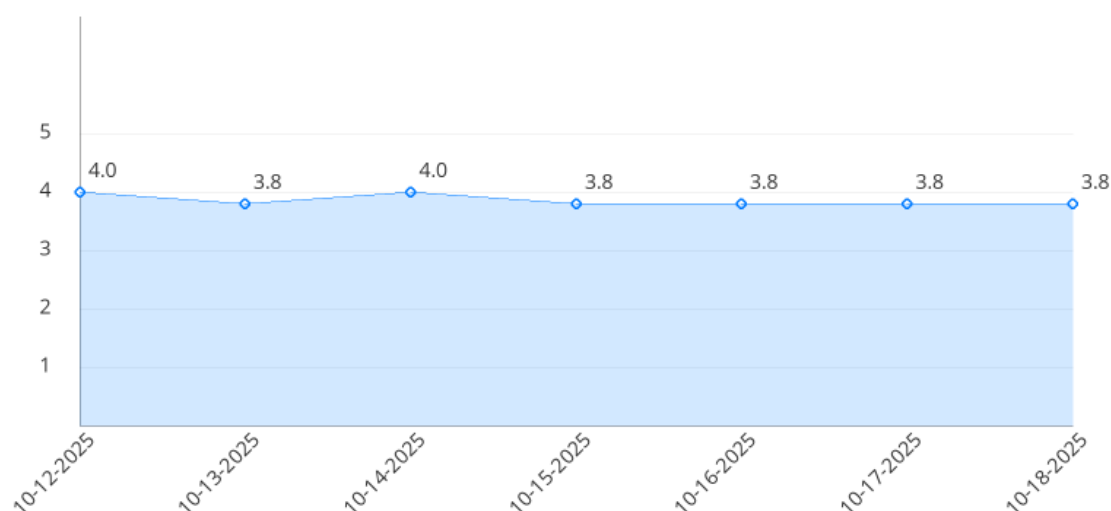

Pandemics

Score Trend (Week of October 12–18, 2025)



This week, the pandemic risk level fluctuated between high and moderate, primarily driven by significant outbreaks of influenza and measles, ongoing challenges with COVID-19, and emerging threats like avian flu and MERS. The risk was heightened by vaccine misinformation and public health response challenges, which have affected vaccine uptake and efficacy. Notably, Japan experienced severe influenza outbreaks, while the US faced significant measles cases. The persistence of avian flu in poultry and MERS in the Middle East further underscored the need for improved vaccination and surveillance strategies. Despite a decline in COVID-19 activity, the overall pandemic threat remains concerning due to these multifaceted challenges.



Pandemics

Recommended Risk Reduction Actions

- **[Government]** Enhance funding and resources for vaccination campaigns to improve coverage and prevent measles and flu outbreaks.
- **[Public Health Agencies]** Strengthen surveillance and rapid response systems for emerging infectious diseases, especially in regions with ongoing outbreaks.
- **[NGO]** Implement community outreach programs to educate the public on the importance of vaccinations and address vaccine hesitancy.
- **[Industry]** Accelerate research and development of more effective vaccines for influenza, COVID-19, and other emerging infectious diseases.
- **[Media]** Combat misinformation by providing accurate, science-based information about vaccines and infectious diseases to the public.

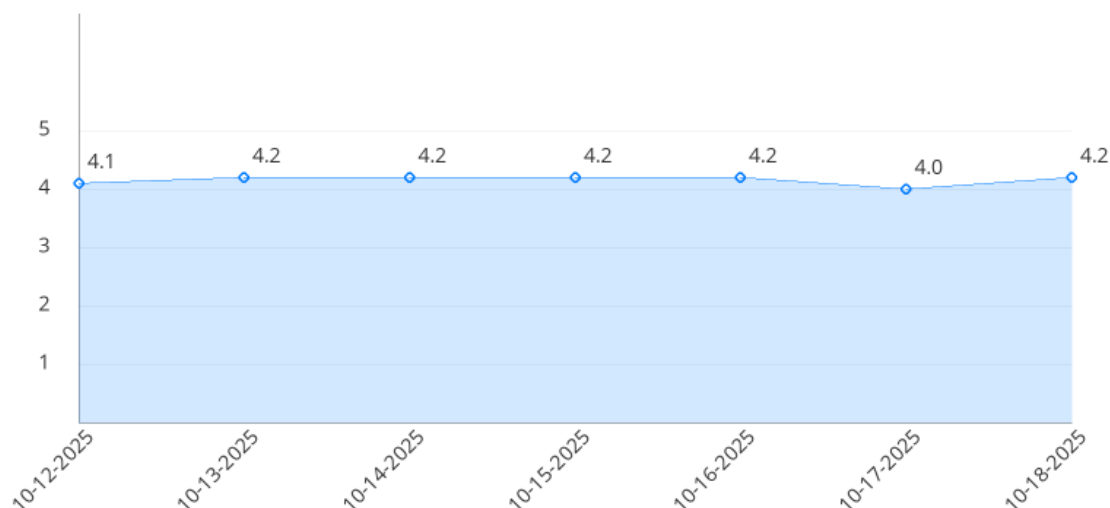

This week, the global threat level from misinformation and disinformation remains high, consistently driven by false claims across political, health, and social domains. AI-generated content and deepfakes are exacerbating the spread of falsehoods, impacting public trust and safety. Disinformation campaigns are prevalent, affecting narratives around elections, health, and climate change. The persistent high risk underscores the need for enhanced detection and mitigation strategies to address the pervasive spread of misinformation across digital platforms.



Information Integrity

Recommended Risk Reduction Actions

- **[Government]** Implement stricter regulations and penalties for the dissemination of false information, particularly in critical areas like health and elections.
- **[Industry]** Enhance AI and algorithmic tools to better detect and flag misinformation on social media platforms.
- **[NGO]** Develop and integrate media literacy programs to equip individuals with skills to critically evaluate information.
- **[Education]** Collaborate with educational institutions to integrate media literacy programs into school curricula.
- **[Public]** Encourage critical thinking and verification of information sources before sharing content online.

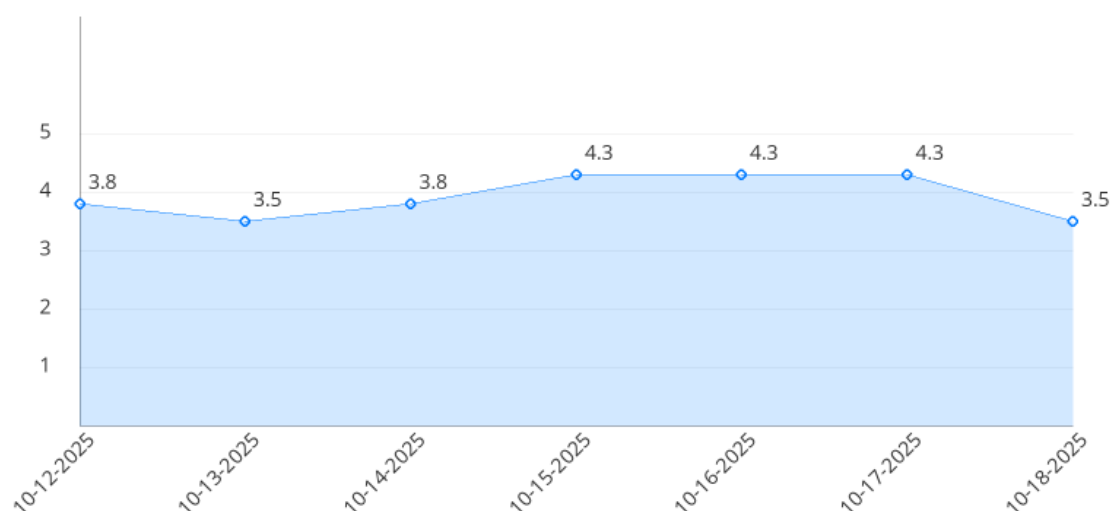

Score Trend (Week of October 12–18, 2025)



This week, several potential Black Swan events have emerged, primarily centered around geopolitical and economic instability. Japan's political landscape is experiencing significant shifts with the appointment of its first female prime minister and the breakdown of its ruling coalition, which, coupled with trade tensions, poses a risk to global economic stability. Concurrently, the U.S. has imposed steep tariffs on Chinese imports, threatening to disrupt global trade dynamics. Additionally, the expansion of Israeli settlements in the West Bank is escalating tensions in the Middle East, while in Europe, the emergence of West Nile Virus cases in Paris highlights an unexpected public health threat. These developments underscore the need for strategic monitoring and proactive measures to mitigate potential global impacts.

- **[Government]** Facilitate diplomatic dialogues between Japan, the U.S., and China to de-escalate trade tensions and promote economic stability.
- **[Industry]** Diversify supply chains and explore alternative markets to mitigate risks associated with geopolitical instability and trade disruptions.
- **[Public Health]** Increase surveillance and monitoring of mosquito populations in Europe to track and prevent the spread of West Nile Virus.
- **[NGO]** Engage in diplomatic efforts to mediate and de-escalate tensions in the Middle East, focusing on humanitarian support.
- **[Media]** Provide accurate and timely information to the public regarding geopolitical developments to prevent misinformation and panic-driven market reactions.

Week in Review: October 12–18, 2025

This week, existential risk trends across the six domains show a mix of elevated and moderate concerns. In the nuclear domain, modernization efforts and geopolitical tensions, particularly involving Russia and North Korea, have kept the threat level high, compounded by AI integration and reduced oversight due to government shutdowns. AI risks remain moderate, with advancements raising concerns about power concentration and misuse, prompting legislative actions for safety and ethical guidelines. Climate change risks persist at high levels, driven by extreme weather and insufficient policy responses, highlighting the need for coordinated global action. Pandemic risks fluctuate between high and moderate, with outbreaks of influenza and measles, alongside challenges from vaccine misinformation and emerging threats like avian flu and MERS. Information integrity remains a high-risk area due to the proliferation of misinformation and AI-generated content affecting public trust. Lastly, potential Black Swan events are emerging from geopolitical and economic instability, notably in Japan, the U.S., and the Middle East, emphasizing the importance of strategic monitoring and proactive measures.
