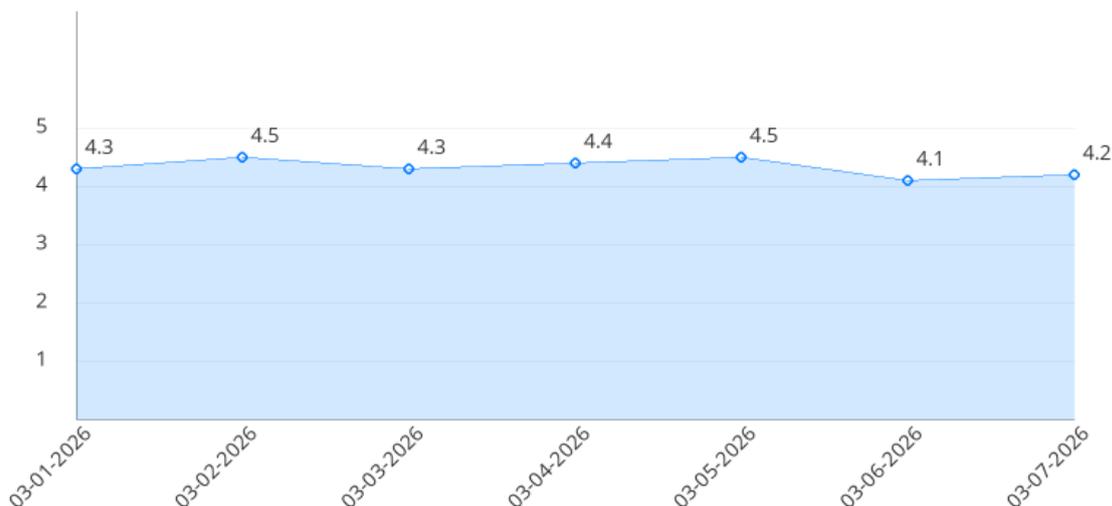

# Nuclear War

## Score Trend (Week of March 1–7, 2026)

- **[Industry]** Implement strict oversight and control measures over AI systems involved in military decision-making to prevent unintended escalations.
- **[Academia]** Conduct research on the impact of AI in nuclear decision-making and develop guidelines to ensure safe integration into military systems.

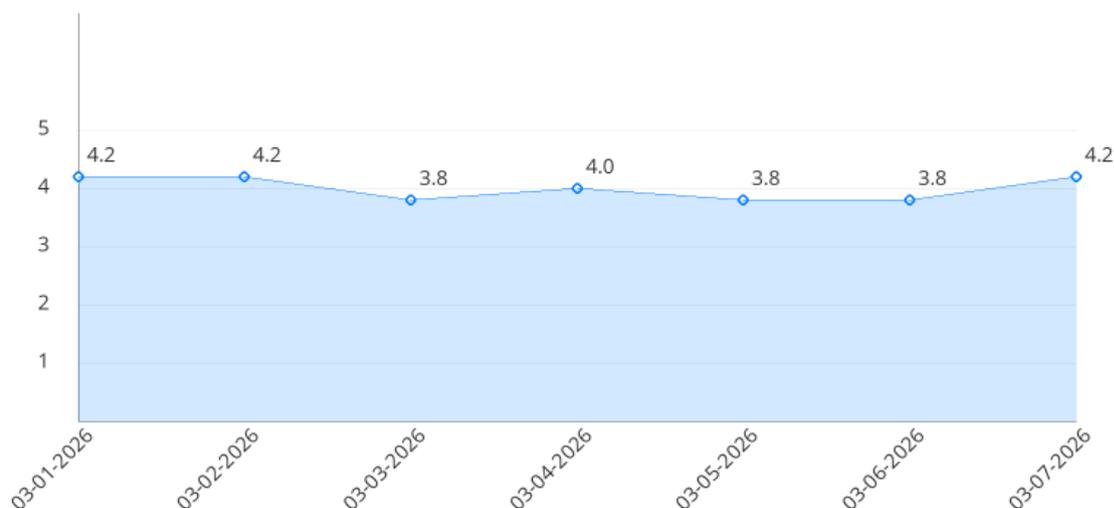

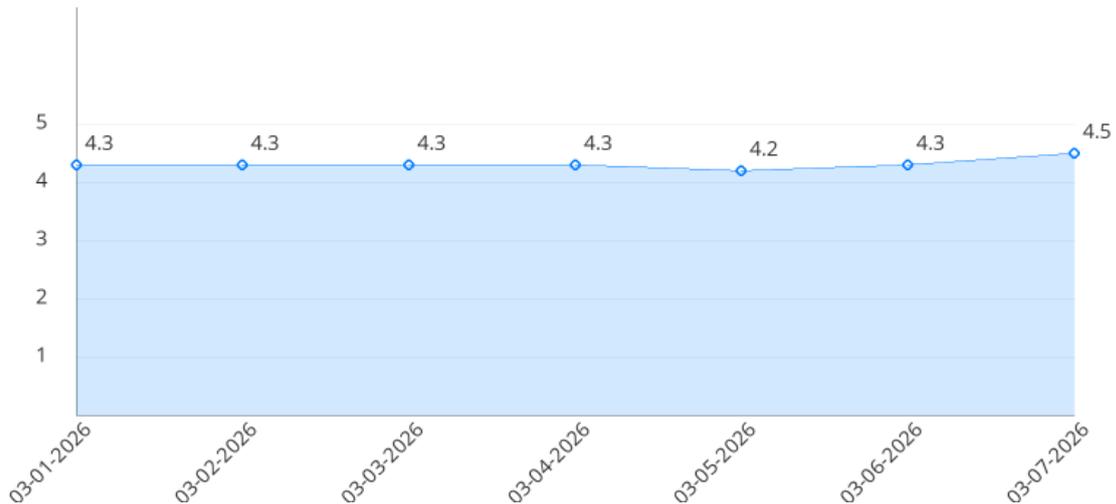

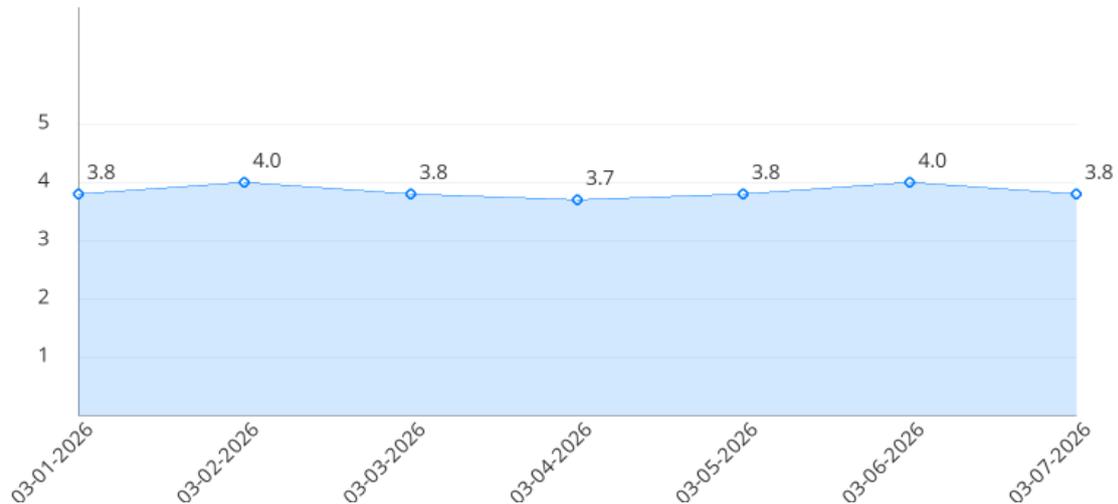

## Score Trend (Week of March 1–7, 2026)



This week, the pandemic risk fluctuated between moderate and high, primarily due to ongoing outbreaks of flu, avian flu, measles, and the persistent effects of COVID-19. The situation is exacerbated by misinformation and skepticism surrounding vaccines, which is impacting vaccine uptake and deployment. 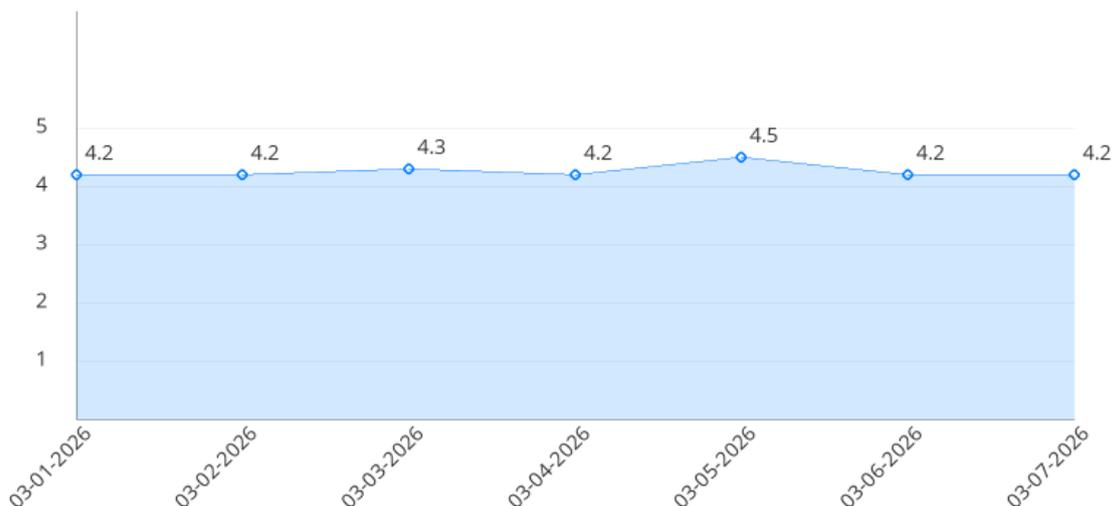

# Information Integrity

The overall trend indicates a persistent challenge in maintaining information integrity in the face of sophisticated misinformation tactics.



# Information Integrity

## Recommended Risk Reduction Actions

- **[Government]** Implement stricter regulations and penalties for entities involved in the creation and dissemination of AI-generated misinformation, especially during geopolitical conflicts.
- **[Industry]** Enhance AI detection tools to better identify and flag AI-generated fake content and deepfakes on social media platforms in real-time.
- **[Education]** Develop and integrate comprehensive media literacy programs into school curricula to equip individuals with skills to critically evaluate and identify misinformation.
- **[NGO]** Launch public awareness campaigns to educate the public on identifying and reporting misinformation, focusing on the dangers of AI-generated content.
- **[International Organizations]** Facilitate cross-border cooperation to address and mitigate the spread of misinformation and disinformation, particularly in conflict zones and during election periods.

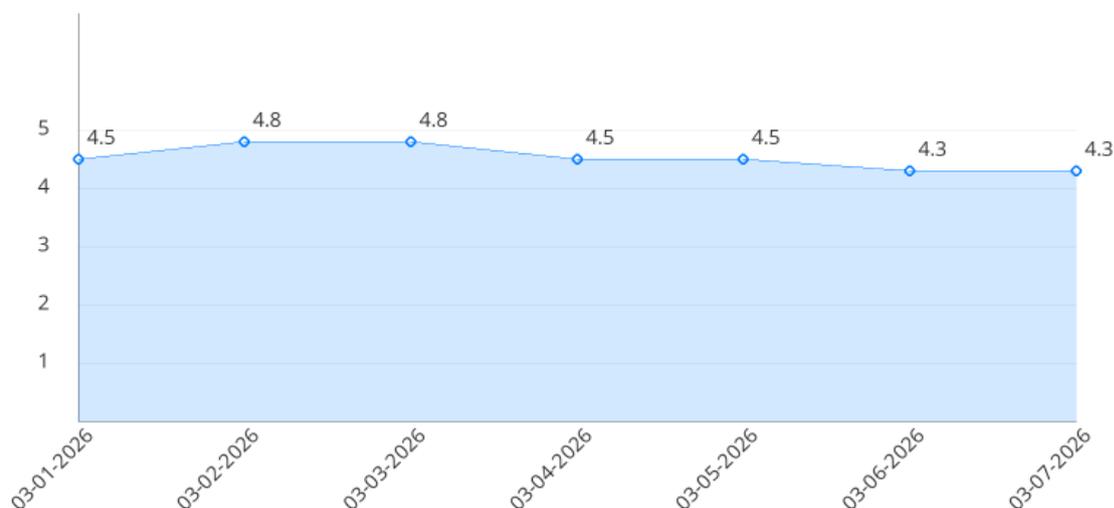
