

Nuclear War

Score Trend (Week of March 8–14, 2026)



This week, the global nuclear threat level has been elevated due to several geopolitical developments. The potential shift in Finland's nuclear policy, which could lead to hosting nuclear weapons, has increased tensions with Russia. Concurrently, ongoing conflicts involving nuclear-capable states, particularly between the U.S. and Iran, as well as Iran and Israel, have further exacerbated the situation. The rhetoric surrounding nuclear capabilities in North Korea and the modernization of nuclear arsenals also contribute to the heightened risk. Overall, the combination of these factors underscores the urgent need for diplomatic efforts to manage and reduce nuclear threats.

- **[Government]** Facilitate urgent diplomatic talks between Finland, Russia, and NATO to address security concerns and prevent escalation.
- **[NGO]** Advocate for public awareness campaigns on the importance of nuclear disarmament and arms control.
- **[International Organizations]** Convene an emergency summit to address the escalating tensions in the Middle East and promote dialogue between Israel and Iran.
- **[Industry]** Invest in technologies that improve nuclear detection and monitoring to prevent unauthorized use.
- **[Academia]** Support initiatives that promote nuclear disarmament and non-proliferation education to raise public awareness and influence policy.



The recurring themes include the need for transparency, ethical guidelines, and global cooperation to mitigate these risks. Overall, the focus remains on ensuring that AI advancements do not lead to unintended negative consequences, particularly in sensitive areas like military and critical infrastructure.





Pandemics



Score Trend (Week of March 8–14, 2026)



This week, the pandemic risk level has fluctuated between high and moderate, primarily due to ongoing outbreaks of measles, flu, and emerging avian flu cases. These outbreaks are exacerbated by challenges such as vaccine hesitancy, misinformation, and difficulties in vaccine deployment. The risk score began at 4.2 and decreased to 3.8, indicating a slight improvement but still a significant threat. The persistence of these outbreaks is compounded by ongoing impacts from COVID-19 and funding cuts affecting public health responsiveness. Efforts to combat misinformation and improve vaccine uptake remain critical to managing these threats effectively.



Score Trend (Week of March 8–14, 2026)



This week, the risk of misinformation remains high, primarily driven by the use of AI-generated content in disinformation campaigns. The spread of fake imagery and videos, particularly related to geopolitical tensions such as the US-Iran conflict, is eroding trust in media. State actors are actively involved in these campaigns, further complicating efforts to maintain information integrity. The persistence of high misinformation scores underscores the need for robust countermeasures, including enhanced detection tools and public education. The situation is exacerbated by the rapid dissemination of false information through social media and malicious apps targeting vulnerable groups.



Information Integrity

Recommended Risk Reduction Actions

- **[Government]** Implement stricter regulations and penalties for the creation and dissemination of AI-generated misinformation, particularly in sensitive areas like national security.
- **[Industry]** Enhance AI detection algorithms to better identify and flag deepfakes and other forms of digital manipulation in real-time social media environments.
- **[NGO]** Launch public awareness campaigns to educate citizens on identifying misinformation and the dangers it poses to societal and political stability.
- **[Education]** Develop and integrate comprehensive digital literacy programs to help individuals discern credible information from falsehoods.
- **[International Organizations]** Foster global cooperation to address cross-border misinformation campaigns and develop unified strategies for maintaining information integrity.



Score Trend (Week of March 8–14, 2026)



This week, the primary Black Swan risk involves escalating geopolitical tensions between Israel and Iran, which have the potential to trigger a broader conflict in the Middle East. These tensions are compounded by threats of military retaliation and could significantly impact global energy stability due to disruptions in oil and natural gas supplies. Additionally, there are concerns about nuclear threats from North Korea and Russia, which add to the geopolitical instability. Environmental risks also emerged, with unexpected landslides and dry-season floods indicating potential cascading disasters. Furthermore, an unusually high rate of solar flares poses a risk to global communication and power systems, highlighting the need for robust preparedness measures.

- **[Industry]** Invest in space weather monitoring and strengthen infrastructure to mitigate the impacts of solar flares on communication and power systems.

This week, existential risk trends across the six domains have shown notable developments, with heightened concerns in several areas. In the nuclear domain, geopolitical tensions have increased, particularly with potential nuclear policy changes in Finland and ongoing conflicts involving nuclear-capable states. AI risks remain significant due to advancements and strategic partnerships, raising concerns about misuse, especially in military applications. Climate change risks are high, driven by accelerated global warming and inadequate policy responses. Pandemic risks have slightly decreased but remain significant due to ongoing outbreaks and challenges in vaccine deployment. Information integrity is threatened by AI-generated disinformation, particularly in geopolitical contexts, necessitating stronger countermeasures. In the Black Swan domain, escalating tensions between Israel and Iran, alongside environmental and solar flare risks, underscore the need for comprehensive preparedness strategies.
