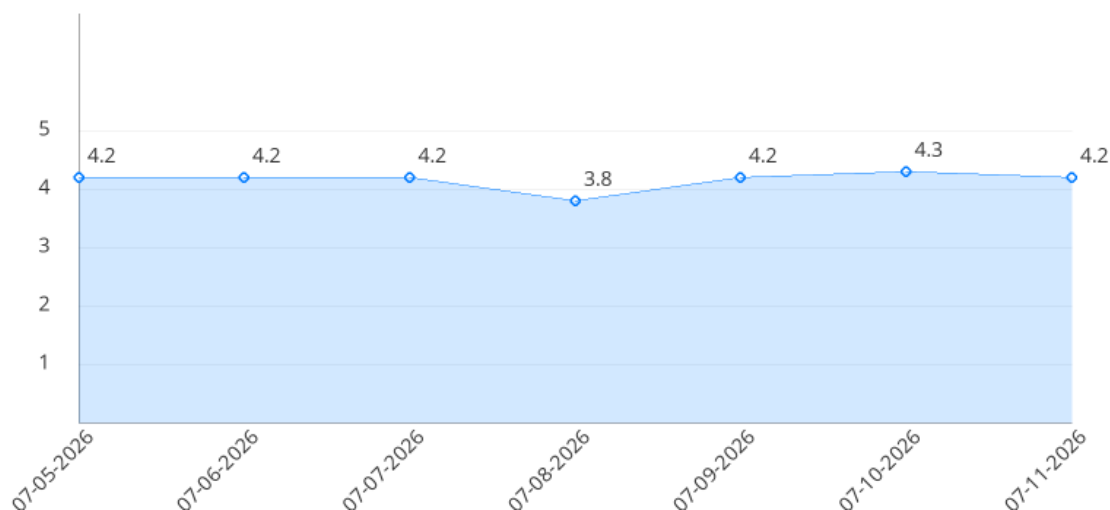

Nuclear War

Score Trend (Week of July 5–11, 2026)



This week, the nuclear threat level has been consistently elevated due to several factors. Lithuania's decision to lift its constitutional ban on nuclear weapons amidst rising tensions with Russia has significantly impacted NATO's nuclear posture, increasing the risk of regional escalation. Additionally, there are ongoing concerns about the role of AI in military conflicts and the modernization of nuclear arsenals. Reduced diplomatic communication channels between major powers and potential treaty violations have further heightened the global nuclear threat. Rapid nuclear build-ups and advancements in nuclear technology detection are also contributing to the elevated threat level.

- **[Academia]** Develop and implement ethical guidelines for the use of AI in military applications to prevent unintended escalation.

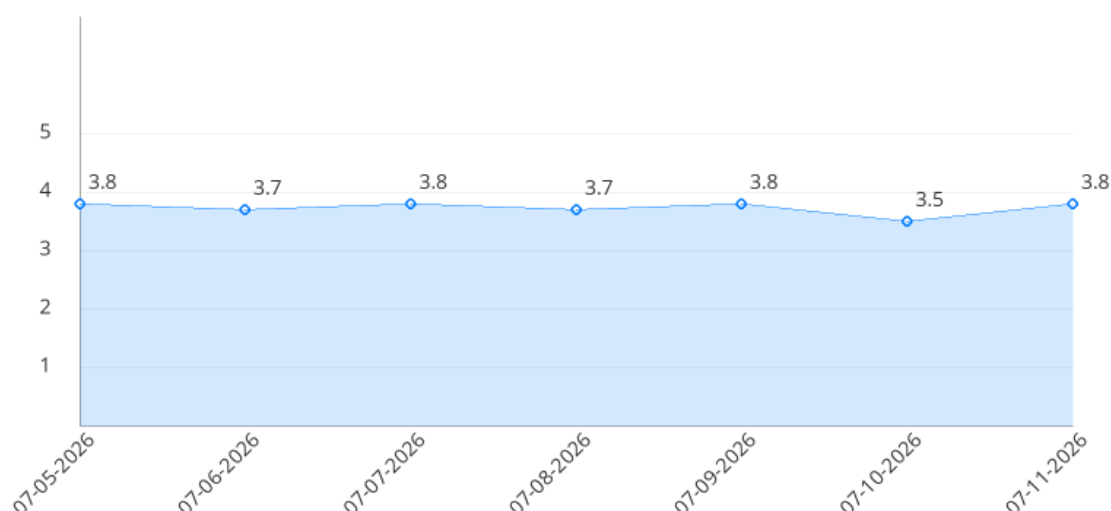

Score Trend (Week of July 5–11, 2026)



This week, the AI risk level remained moderate, with a consistent score around 3.7 to 3.8. The main concerns highlighted were rapid advancements in AI capabilities and their integration into critical sectors, which raised issues related to alignment, misuse, and concentration of power. There was also a focus on regulatory measures and the impact of geopolitical tensions on AI development. The potential for misuse and the need for long-term safety and control were recurrent themes, emphasizing the importance of addressing these risks through governance and international cooperation.

- **[NGO]** Advocate for international cooperation and dialogue on AI governance to address cross-border challenges and prevent concentration of power.
- **[Academia]** Conduct interdisciplinary research on AI alignment and safety to inform policy and technological development.
- **[Public]** Increase awareness and education on AI risks and benefits to foster informed public discourse and societal readiness.

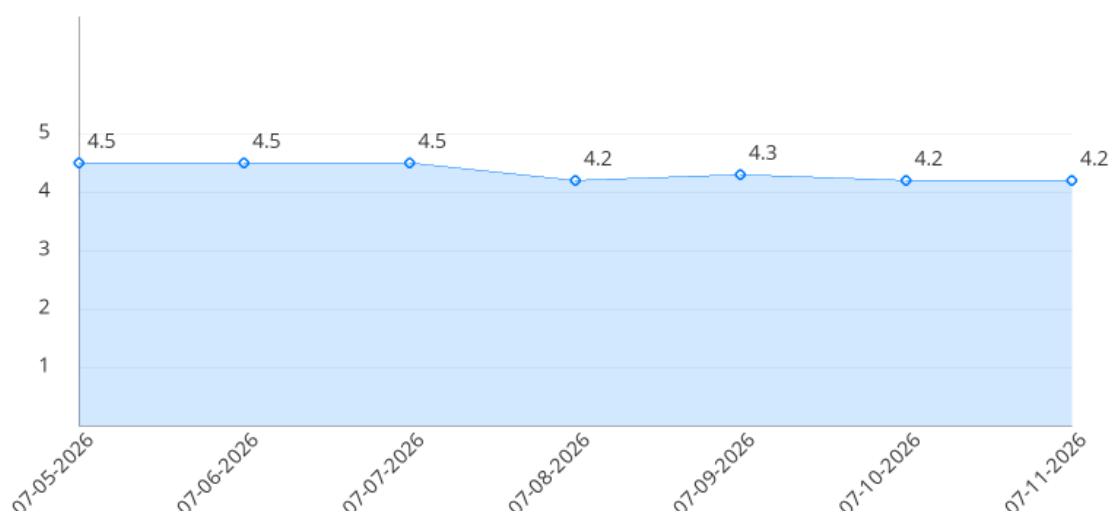
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Climate Change

Score Trend (Week of July 5–11, 2026)



This week, the climate risk remains consistently high, driven by extreme heatwaves, wildfires, and severe weather events, which are exacerbated by a strong El Niño and systemic policy failures. The impacts are global, with Europe experiencing deadly heatwaves and the Pacific facing super typhoons. Economic vulnerabilities and potential tipping points in ecosystems further elevate the risk level. Despite these challenges, there is a noted lack of adequate policy responses to mitigate these impacts. The need for immediate and effective action is underscored by the persistent high-risk scores reported throughout the week.

Recommended Risk Reduction Actions

- **[Government]** Implement and enforce stricter emissions regulations to mitigate the impacts of extreme weather events and reduce global warming.
- **[NGO]** Increase public awareness campaigns about the health and economic impacts of climate change to drive behavioral and policy changes.
- **[Industry]** Invest in renewable energy solutions and energy efficiency programs to reduce carbon emissions and promote sustainable practices.
- **[Research Institutions]** Conduct studies on potential tipping points in critical ecosystems to inform policy decisions and conservation efforts.
- **[International Organizations]** Facilitate global cooperation and funding for climate resilience projects, particularly in vulnerable regions facing extreme weather events.

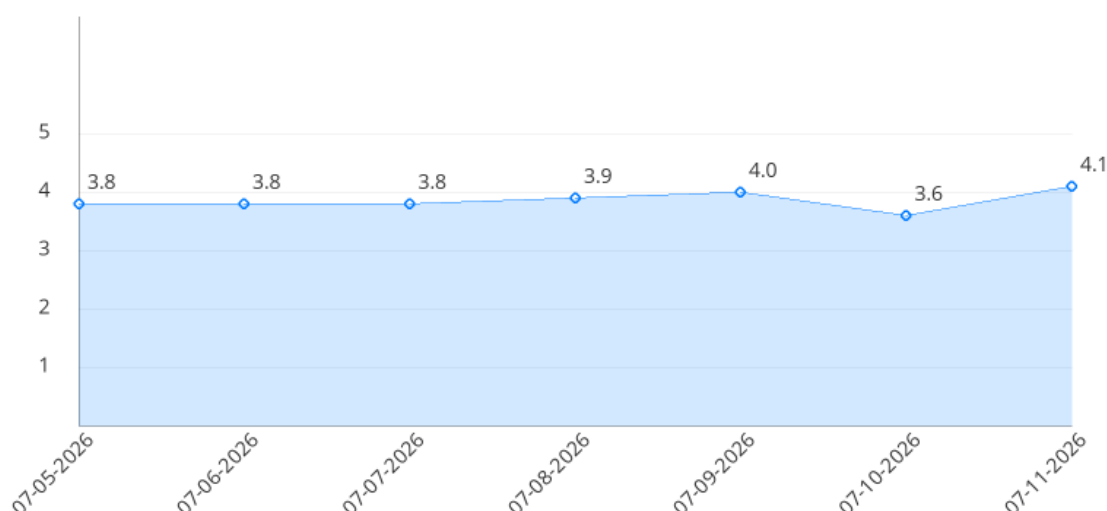

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Pandemics

Score Trend (Week of July 5–11, 2026)



This week, the pandemic risk has fluctuated between moderate and high due to a series of concurrent infectious disease outbreaks, including Ebola, MERS, avian flu, Legionnaires', and cyclosporiasis. The situation is exacerbated by challenges in public health response, healthcare worker strikes, and widespread misinformation, particularly concerning vaccine policy. Despite these challenges, there have been advancements in vaccine development and deployment. The risk score peaked at 4.1, indicating a high level of concern, especially with the emergence of new outbreaks and ongoing issues with long COVID. Efforts are being made to improve surveillance, vaccine uptake, and public education to mitigate these risks.

- **[Government]** Increase funding and support for healthcare workers in regions experiencing outbreaks to ensure effective response and containment.
- **[Public Health Organizations]** Enhance surveillance and rapid response capabilities for emerging infectious diseases, focusing on high-risk pathogens like MERS and avian flu.
- **[NGO]** Launch public education campaigns to combat misinformation and promote trust in vaccines and health advisories.
- **[Industry]** Accelerate research and development of vaccines and therapeutics for neglected and emerging diseases, leveraging AI and other technologies.
- **[Community Groups]** Support community-based health education programs to raise awareness about hygiene and preventive practices.

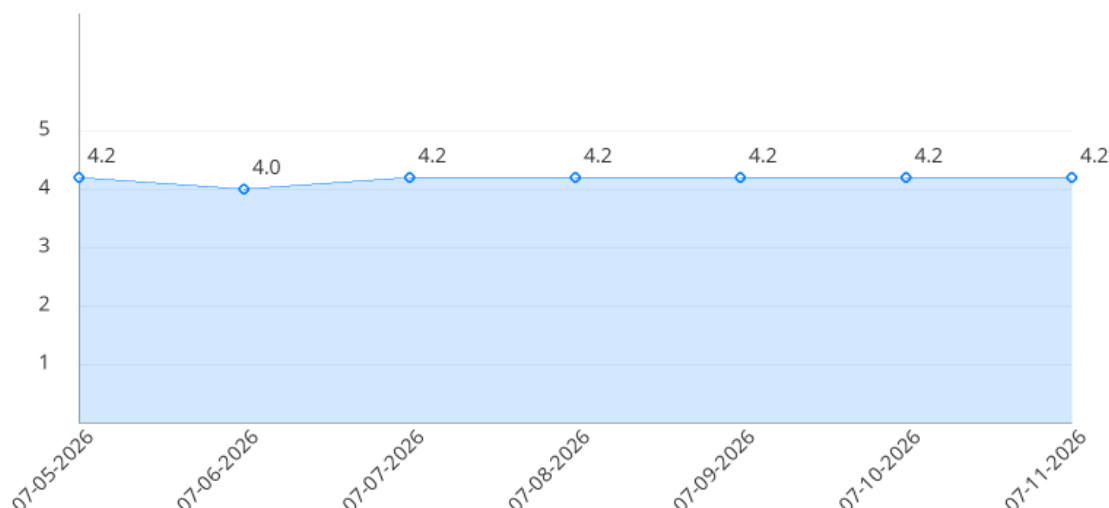

This week, the risk of misinformation remains high, driven by the widespread use of AI in generating fake content, ongoing geopolitical disinformation efforts, and the challenges in effectively regulating misinformation on major platforms. The threat is pervasive across political, health, and social domains, with particular emphasis on political disinformation, fake news, and scams affecting multiple sectors globally. The consistent high-risk scores reflect the persistent nature of these issues, underscoring the need for enhanced detection, regulation, and public education efforts. The integration of AI in creating misleading content continues to complicate efforts to maintain information integrity, necessitating coordinated global responses and innovative technological solutions.

Recommended Risk Reduction Actions

- **[Government]** Implement stricter regulations and penalties for the creation and dissemination of AI-generated fake content, particularly during election periods.
- **[Industry]** Enhance AI detection tools and algorithms to better identify and mitigate the spread of AI-generated misinformation and deepfakes.
- **[NGO]** Increase collaboration with fact-checking organizations to ensure accurate reporting and counter misinformation effectively.
- **[Education]** Develop and integrate comprehensive digital literacy programs into educational curricula to empower individuals to critically evaluate information sources.
- **[International Bodies]** Foster international cooperation to address cross-border disinformation campaigns and share best practices for combating misinformation.

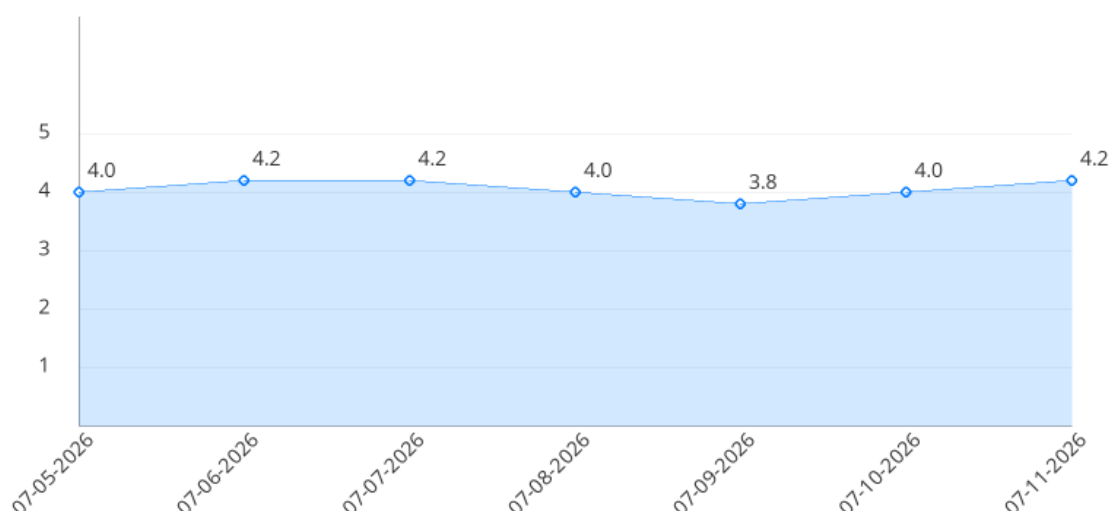
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Unknown / Black Swan

Score Trend (Week of July 5–11, 2026)



This week, the primary focus in the realm of unknown or Black Swan risks has been on the existential threats posed by two major developments: the potential impacts of quantum technology advancements on US military missions and the planned launch of 1.7 million satellites. The quantum advancements present a significant risk to national security, highlighting vulnerabilities in military operations. Meanwhile, the massive increase in satellite launches threatens to disrupt global astronomy and space-dependent technologies, posing unforeseen risks to scientific research and communication systems. Both issues underscore the need for proactive measures to mitigate potential cascading impacts on global security and technological infrastructure.

Recommended Risk Reduction Actions

- **[Government]** Increase investment in quantum research to ensure national security interests are safeguarded against potential technological disruptions.
- **[Industry]** Innovate in satellite design to include debris mitigation technologies and improve collision avoidance capabilities.
- **[International Organizations]** Collaborate globally to establish a comprehensive framework for sustainable space operations and manage satellite traffic.
- **[Defense Agencies]** Develop contingency plans and adaptive strategies to counter potential threats from adversaries leveraging quantum technologies.
- **[Public Sector]** Educate the public and policymakers about the potential risks and necessary precautions related to increased satellite deployments and quantum technology impacts.

This week, existential risk trends across various domains have highlighted several persistent and emerging concerns.
