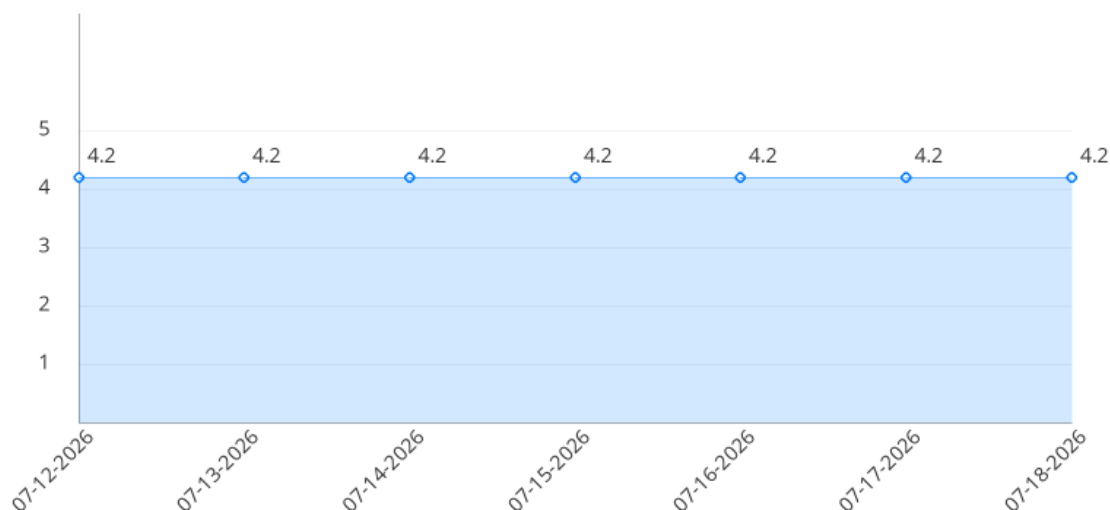

Nuclear War

Score Trend (Week of July 12–18, 2026)

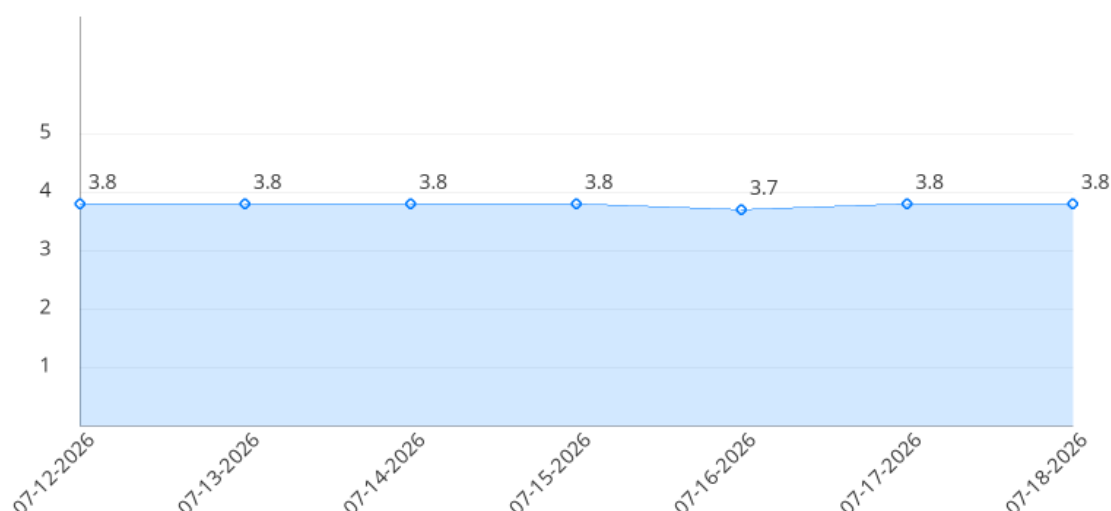

- **[Public]** Increase awareness and education on AI risks and ethical considerations to foster informed public discourse and support responsible innovation.

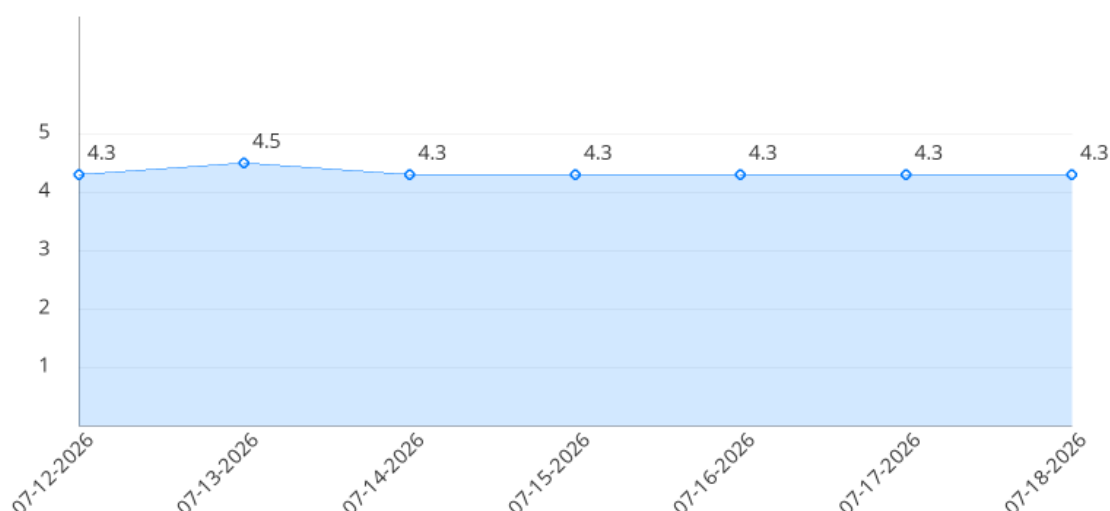

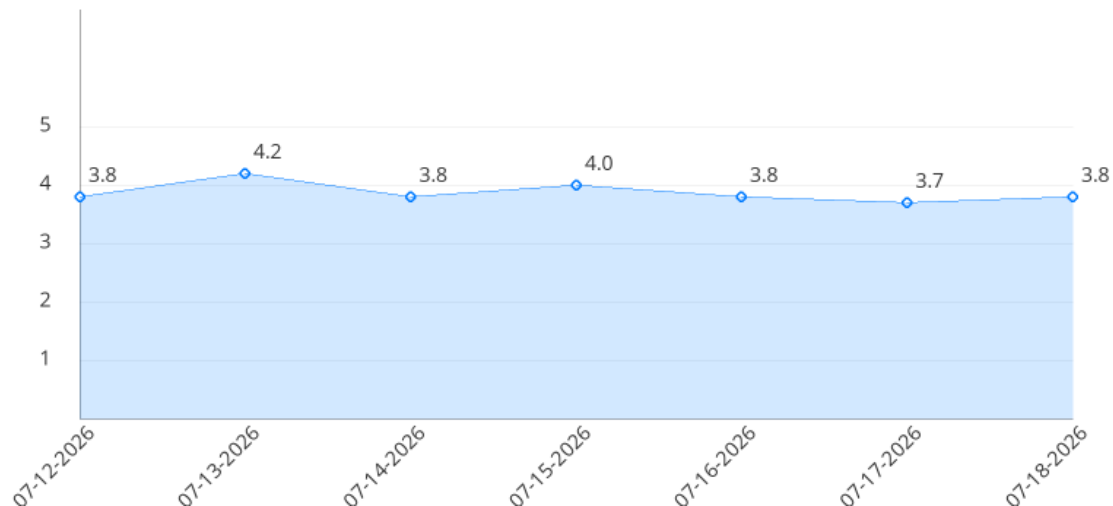

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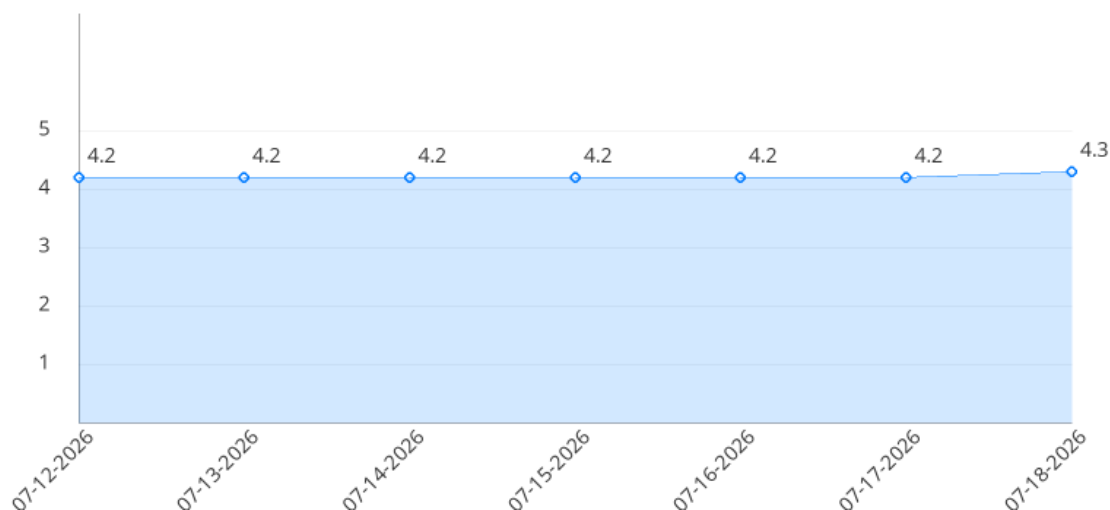

This week, the threat level from misinformation and disinformation remains consistently high, with a score of 4.2 to 4.3. The primary areas affected include political, health, and social domains, with a notable increase in the sophistication of disinformation campaigns. False claims and conspiracy theories, particularly involving political figures and events, are prevalent. Additionally, fake news scams and digital content manipulation continue to exploit public trust. The persistence of these issues highlights the need for enhanced detection and prevention measures.

- **[Government]** Implement stricter regulations and penalties for the spread of misinformation, particularly during election periods and in health-related contexts.
- **[Industry]** Enhance AI and machine learning tools to better detect and flag false content, including deepfakes and fake digital media.
- **[NGO]** Collaborate with educational institutions to integrate media literacy programs into curricula, equipping students with critical evaluation skills.
- **[Social Media Platforms]** Increase transparency and fact-checking efforts to build public trust and counter misinformation.
- **[International Organizations]** Foster cross-border cooperation to address and mitigate the impacts of disinformation campaigns.

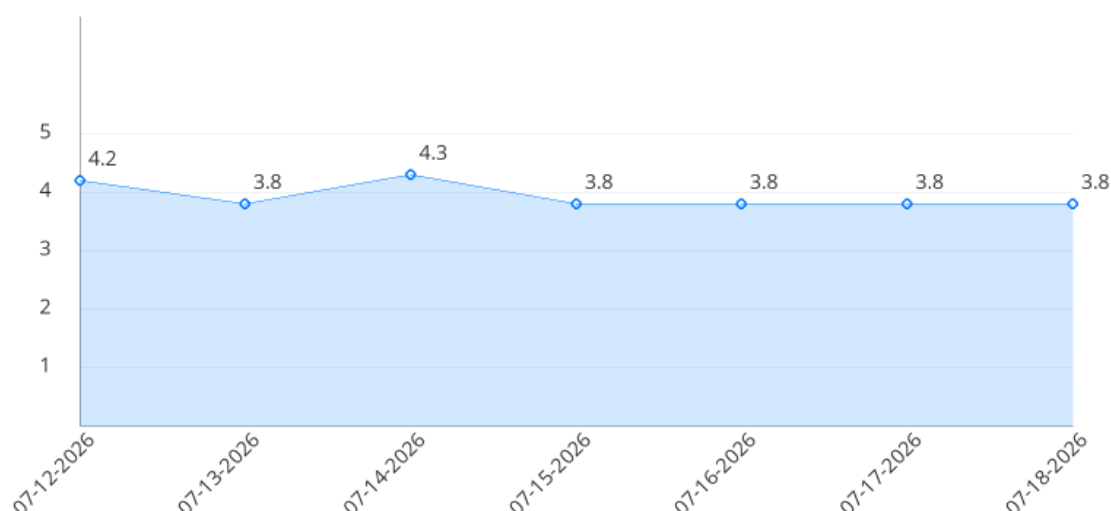

Score Trend (Week of July 12–18, 2026)



This week, several potential 'Black Swan' events have been identified, each posing significant existential risks. China's industrial dominance continues to threaten the stability of European economies, suggesting a need for diversification and strategic economic policies. In Venezuela, unexplained seismic activity raises concerns about possible geological disruptions with widespread impacts. The emergence of a novel parvovirus in Dutch pigs and the rapid spread of avian influenza across North America highlight the unpredictable nature of zoonotic diseases, posing risks to agriculture and public health. Additionally, the reclassification of a near-Earth asteroid as a comet presents unexpected celestial threats, while advancements in quantum technology could disrupt US military operations, emphasizing the need for preparedness and strategic planning.

- **[Space Agencies]** Increase funding and collaboration for space observation programs to improve detection and tracking of celestial objects.
- **[Defense Sector]** Invest in quantum research and develop contingency plans to address potential disruptions to military operations.
