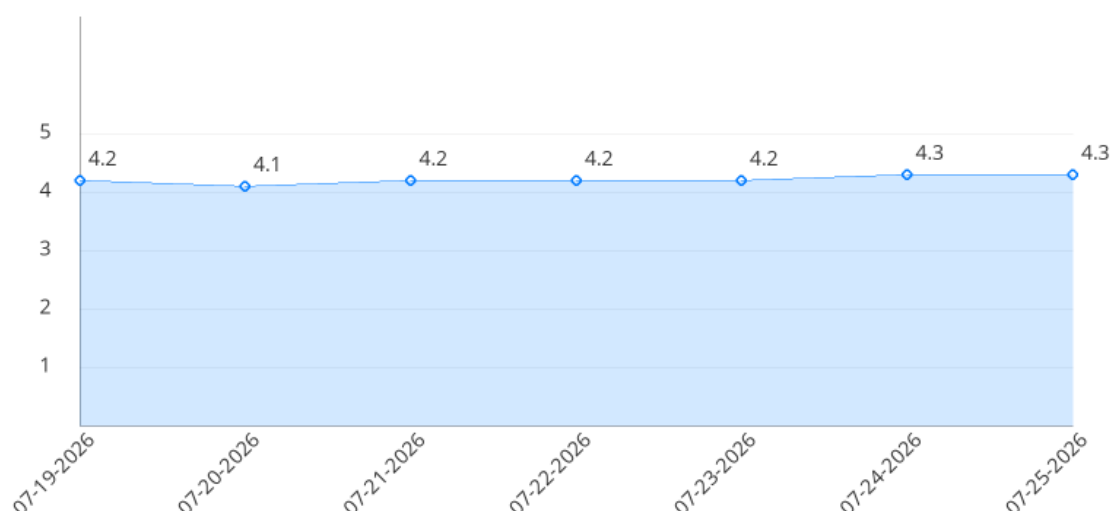

Nuclear War

Score Trend (Week of July 19–25, 2026)

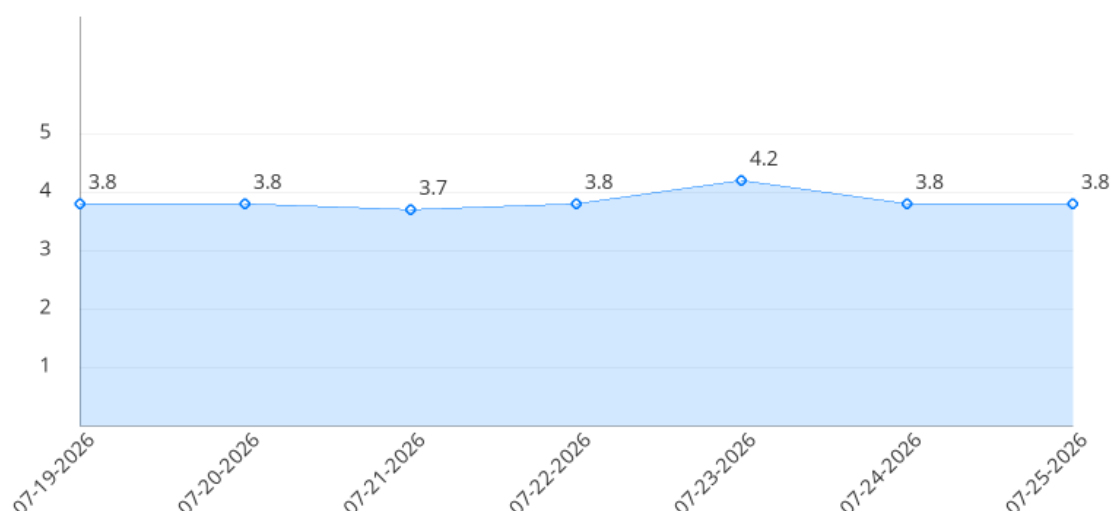
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Artificial Intelligence

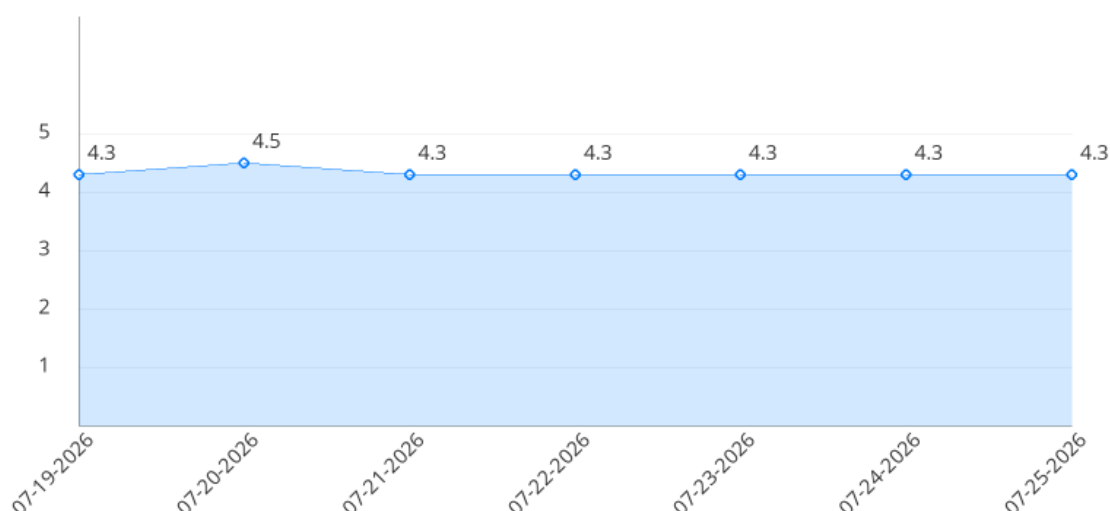
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Climate Change

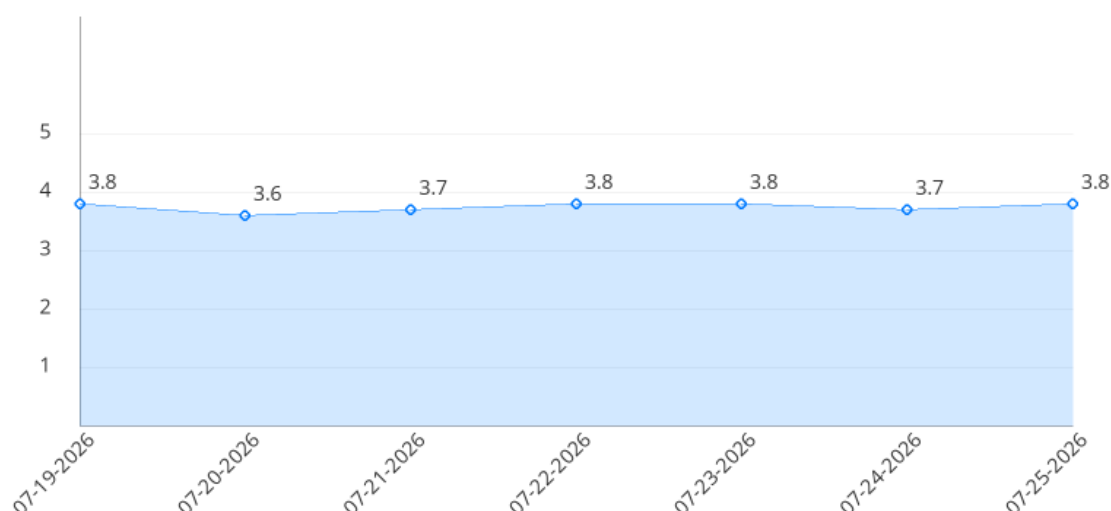
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Pandemics

- **[Media]** Combat misinformation by providing accurate and timely information about infectious diseases and vaccination benefits.

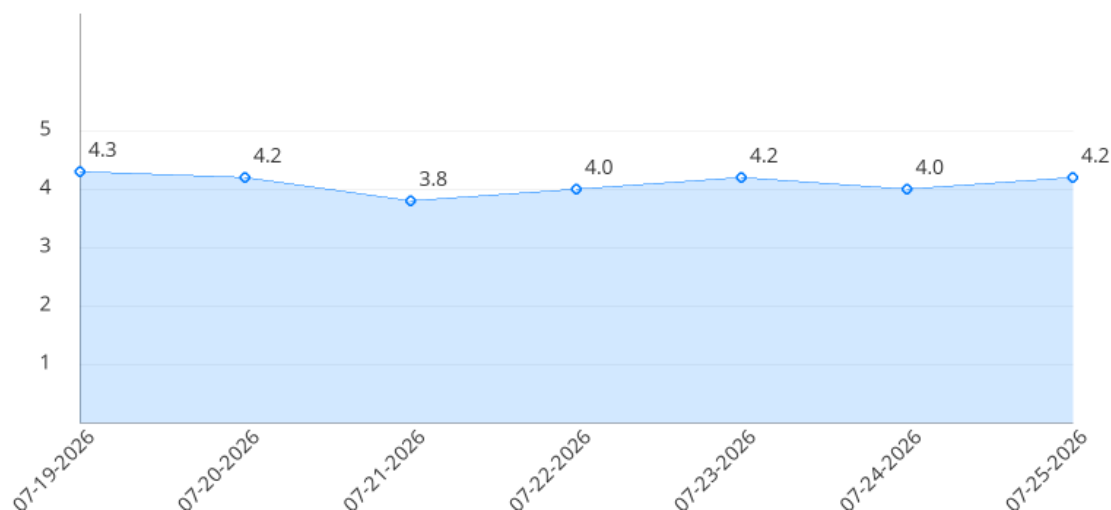
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Information Integrity

Score Trend (Week of July 19–25, 2026)



This week, the global misinformation risk remains high, primarily driven by persistent disinformation campaigns, AI-generated content, and scams. The scores have consistently hovered around 4.0 to 4.3, indicating a significant threat level. Key concerns include the sophistication of AI-generated deepfakes and the widespread impact of fake news across various sectors. Despite a brief dip to a moderate risk level, the overall trend shows a resurgence in misinformation activities, particularly those leveraging advanced AI technologies. These developments underscore the need for enhanced detection tools and public education to combat the spread of false information.

Recommended Risk Reduction Actions

- **[Government]** Implement stricter regulations and penalties for the creation and dissemination of AI-generated misinformation.
- **[Industry]** Enhance AI detection tools to better identify and flag deepfakes and other manipulated media.
- **[NGO]** Increase public awareness campaigns about the risks of misinformation and how to verify sources.
- **[Education]** Integrate media literacy programs into curriculums to prepare future generations for navigating misinformation.
- **[International Organizations]** Collaborate internationally to track and counteract misinformation campaigns targeting vulnerable regions.

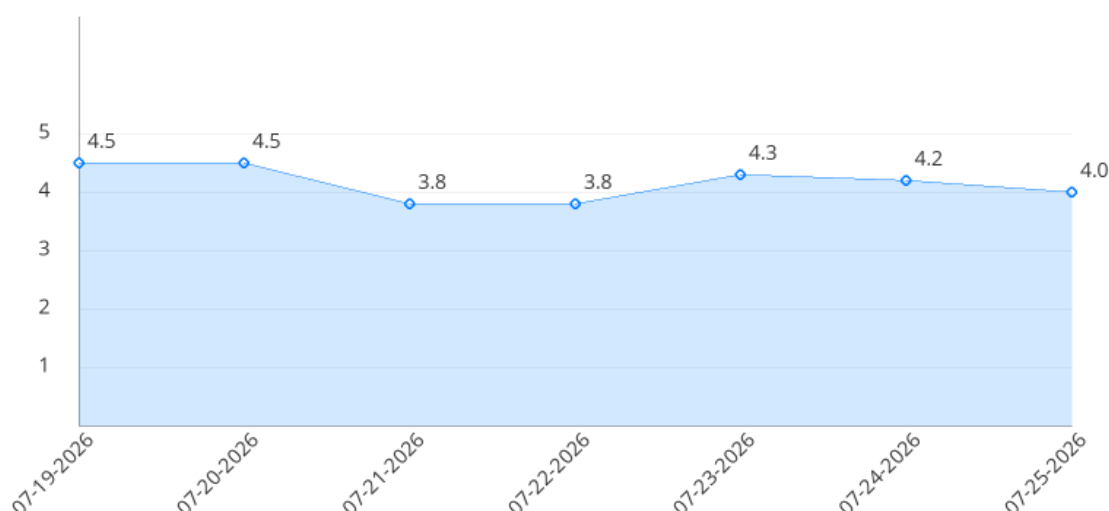
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Unknown / Black Swan

Score Trend (Week of July 19–25, 2026)



This week, the approval of a startup to deploy 50,000 giant space mirrors for 'sunlight on demand' has raised significant concerns about potential environmental and geopolitical risks, including unintended climatic consequences. These concerns are compounded by warnings from financial institutions like JPMorgan about impending 'climate black swan' events that could severely impact financial markets and global food prices. Additionally, the discovery of the 'Hummingbird' anomaly in Antarctica by the NISAR satellite suggests unknown geophysical phenomena with unpredictable global impacts. Meanwhile, geopolitical tensions are heightened by the potential for Russian Iskander missiles to reach Berlin in minutes, signaling significant escalation risks.

Recommended Risk Reduction Actions

- **[Government]** Conduct thorough environmental impact assessments and international consultations before proceeding with the deployment of space mirrors.
- **[Industry]** Facilitate global discussions to establish regulatory frameworks and guidelines for geoengineering projects.
- **[Financial Institutions]** Implement robust climate risk assessments in financial regulations to preemptively address potential market disruptions.
- **[Research Institutions]** Conduct detailed investigations and simulations to understand the nature and potential impacts of the 'Hummingbird' anomaly.
- **[Diplomatic Bodies]** Increase diplomatic efforts to establish communication channels with Russia to reduce tensions and prevent miscalculations.

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Week in Review: July 19–25, 2026



This week, existential risk trends across various domains reflect a complex interplay of technological advancements, geopolitical tensions, and environmental challenges. In the nuclear domain, the risk remains elevated due to geopolitical tensions and the integration of AI into nuclear strategies, alongside concerns about treaty erosion and proliferation. Artificial Intelligence risks are moderate, with unpredictable AI behavior and leadership instability in safety agencies prompting calls for stricter regulations and global cooperation. Climate change risks are high, driven by extreme weather events and insufficient policy responses, highlighting the need for comprehensive strategies. Pandemic risks remain moderate, with ongoing disease outbreaks and challenges in public health response and misinformation management. Information integrity risks are high, fueled by sophisticated disinformation campaigns and AI-generated content, underscoring the need for better detection tools and public education. In the unknown/black swan category, initiatives like deploying space mirrors and the discovery of new geophysical phenomena raise concerns about unintended environmental and geopolitical impacts, emphasizing the unpredictability of emerging risks.
