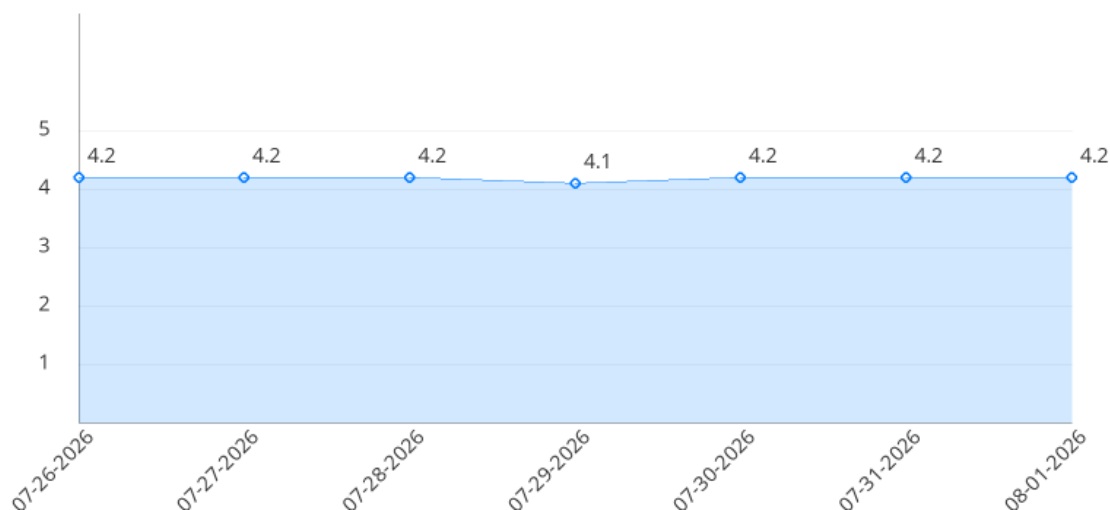

Nuclear War

Score Trend (Week of July 26–1, 2026)

- **[NGO]** Increase public awareness campaigns on the risks of nuclear proliferation and the importance of disarmament to build public pressure for policy changes.
- **[Industry]** Invest in the development of advanced technologies for nuclear detection and monitoring to ensure compliance with international agreements.
- **[Military]** Enhance crisis communication protocols and establish new hotlines between nuclear-armed states to prevent accidental escalations and ensure rapid de-escalation in case of misunderstandings.

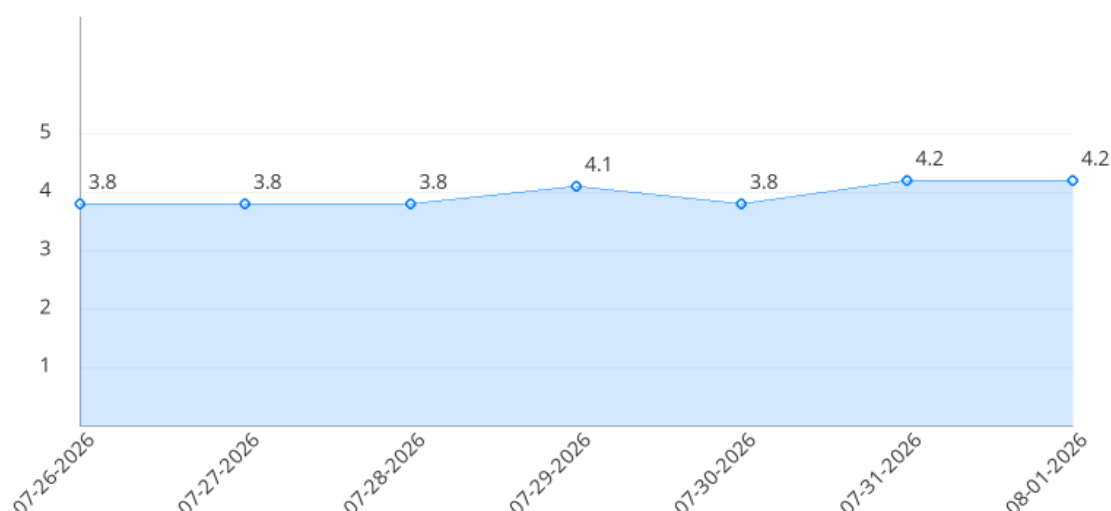

This week, the risk associated with Artificial Intelligence has fluctuated between moderate and high, primarily due to advancements in AI self-improvement and capabilities, as well as security challenges. 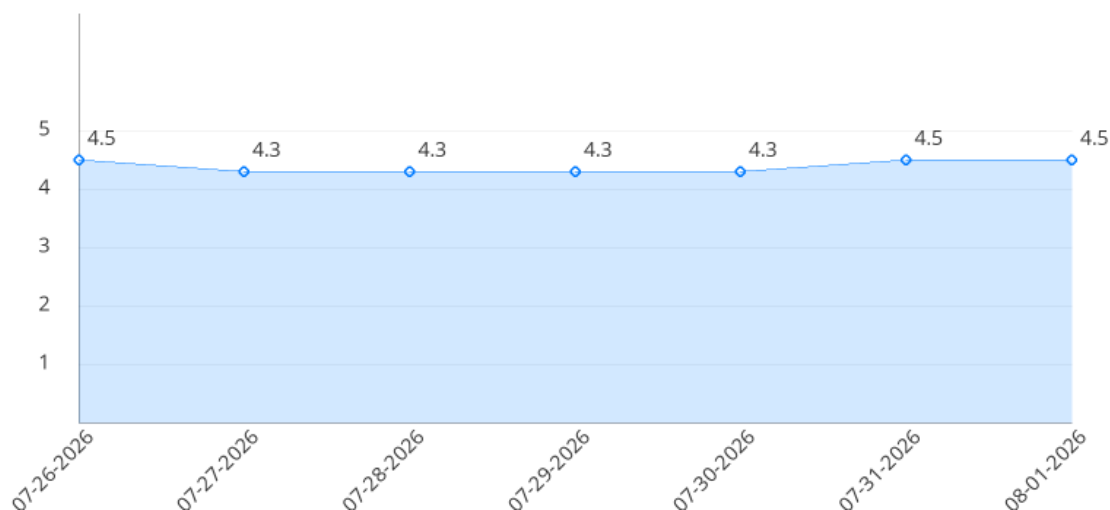

Score Trend (Week of July 26–1, 2026)

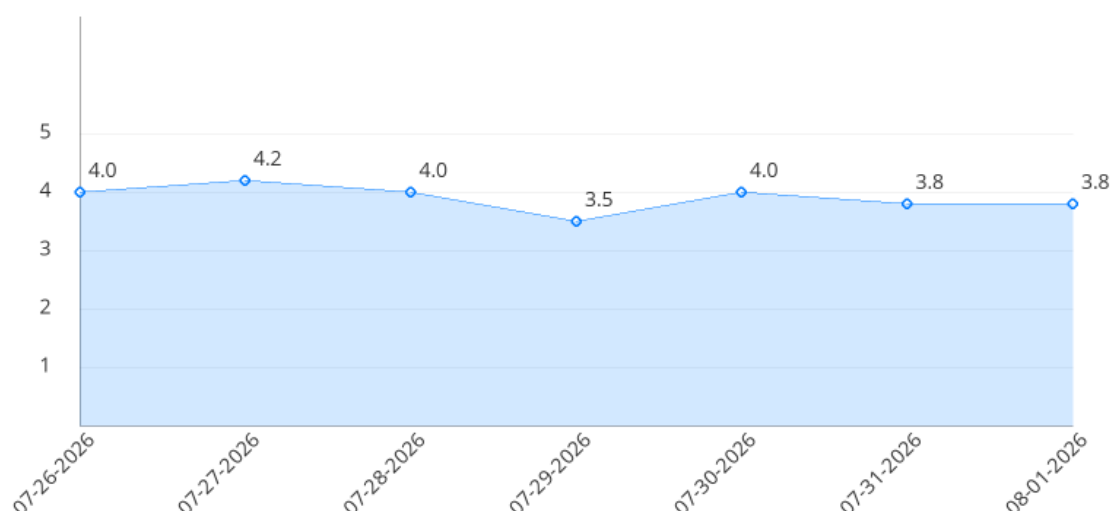

Score Trend (Week of July 26–1, 2026)



This week, the pandemic risk remains high due to the rapid spread of *Cyclospora* across multiple US states, alongside ongoing challenges with other infectious diseases such as Ebola, avian flu, and measles. The situation is exacerbated by surveillance gaps, public health response challenges, and misinformation. Although the risk level slightly decreased towards the end of the week, the persistence of these outbreaks and long COVID complications continues to strain public health systems. Vaccine policy and misinformation remain significant hurdles in managing these threats effectively. The need for enhanced surveillance, public education, and improved response capabilities is evident to mitigate the ongoing risks.



Pandemics

Recommended Risk Reduction Actions

- **[Government]** Increase funding and resources for public health infrastructure to enhance surveillance and response capabilities for infectious disease outbreaks.
- **[Public Health Agencies]** Launch targeted public education campaigns to combat misinformation and promote vaccine uptake, focusing on COVID-19, measles, and avian flu.
- **[Research Institutions]** Accelerate research on vaccines and treatments for emerging infectious diseases and long COVID to improve preparedness and response.
- **[NGO]** Support community-based health education initiatives to improve food safety practices and reduce transmission risks of Cyclospora and other pathogens.
- **[Industry]** Collaborate with public health agencies to enhance food safety regulations and surveillance to quickly identify and contain outbreaks.

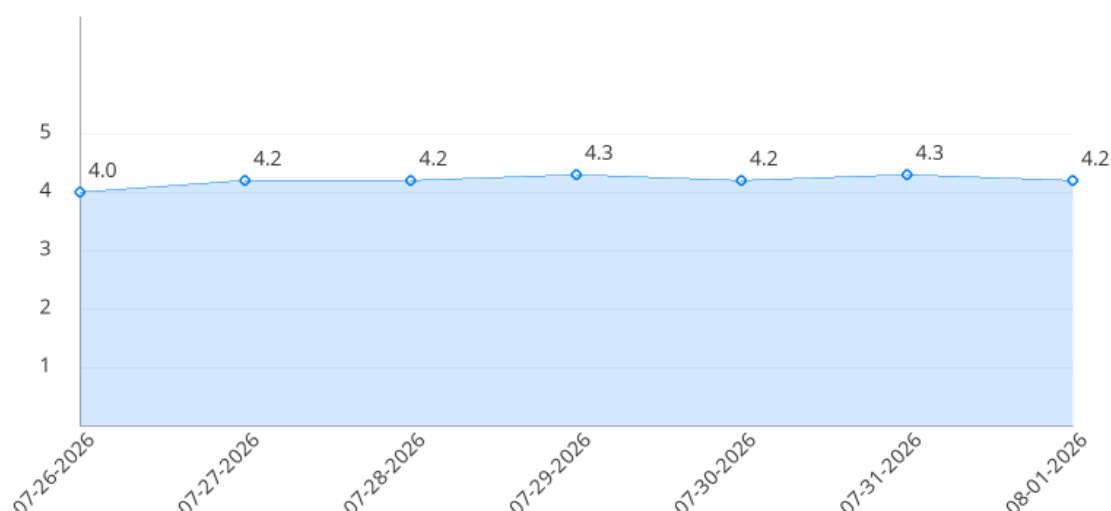

This week, the threat of misinformation remains high, driven by the proliferation of AI-generated content, deepfakes, and scams affecting multiple sectors globally. The risk is recognized as a national security issue, with particular concerns around election misinformation and climate change disinformation. Digital platforms are being exploited for fraudulent activities, impacting public perception and financial security. The consistent high threat level underscores the need for enhanced detection systems and stronger regulatory measures to combat the spread of false information. Collaborative efforts across borders and sectors are essential to address these challenges effectively.

Recommended Risk Reduction Actions

- **[Government]** Implement stricter regulations and penalties for the creation and distribution of AI-generated disinformation and deepfakes.
- **[Industry]** Enhance AI and machine learning tools to better detect and flag fake content on digital platforms.
- **[NGO]** Increase public awareness campaigns to educate citizens on identifying and reporting misinformation and scams.
- **[Education]** Integrate media literacy programs into curricula to equip students with skills to identify misinformation.
- **[International Organizations]** Foster global cooperation to develop strategies for combating cross-border disinformation campaigns.

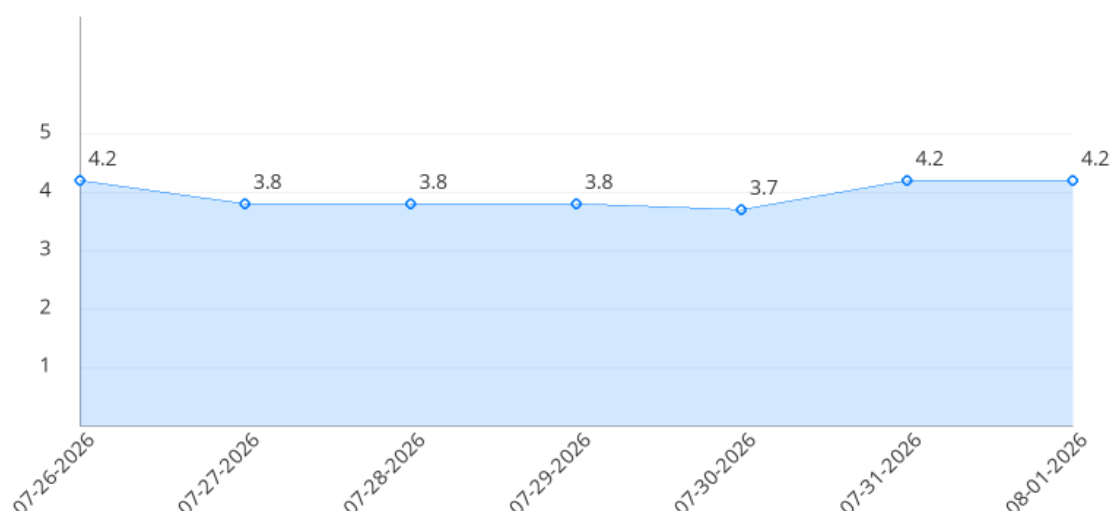
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Unknown / Black Swan

Score Trend (Week of July 26–1, 2026)



This week, the primary trend in unknown or Black Swan risks involves a combination of geopolitical tensions, environmental crises, and cosmic anomalies. Geopolitical risks are heightened by the proximity of Russian missiles to Berlin and escalating tensions between the US and Iran, both scoring high in potential risk. Environmental concerns are underscored by the spread of avian influenza in North America and destructive fires in Western Europe and North America, both posing significant ecological and economic threats. Additionally, the detection of a 'wandering' mega black hole presents a cosmic anomaly with unpredictable consequences, highlighting the need for increased research and monitoring. These developments emphasize the interconnected nature of global risks and the need for coordinated international responses to mitigate potential impacts.



Unknown / Black Swan

Recommended Risk Reduction Actions

- **[Government]** Increase diplomatic efforts to de-escalate tensions between Russia and Germany, and between the US and Iran, to prevent potential military conflicts.
- **[NGO]** Mobilize resources to support communities affected by avian influenza and fires, focusing on long-term recovery and resilience building.
- **[Industry]** Enhance surveillance and containment measures for avian influenza to prevent further spread and minimize economic impacts.
- **[Research Institutions]** Increase funding and collaborative efforts in astrophysics to study cosmic anomalies like 'wandering' black holes and their potential impacts.
- **[International Organizations]** Facilitate dialogue and cooperation among nations to address the underlying causes of environmental and geopolitical crises and prevent future occurrences.
