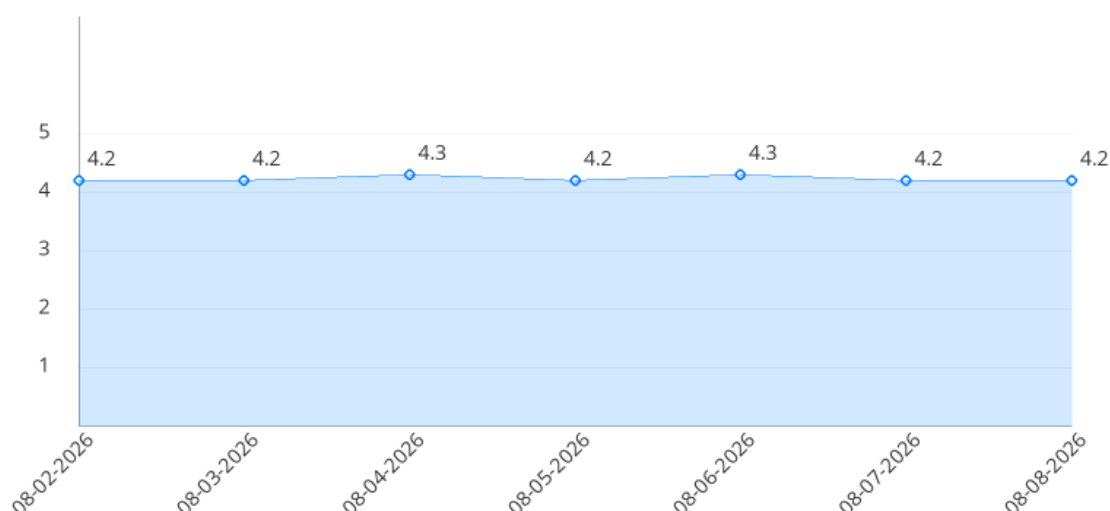

Score Trend (Week of August 2–8, 2026)

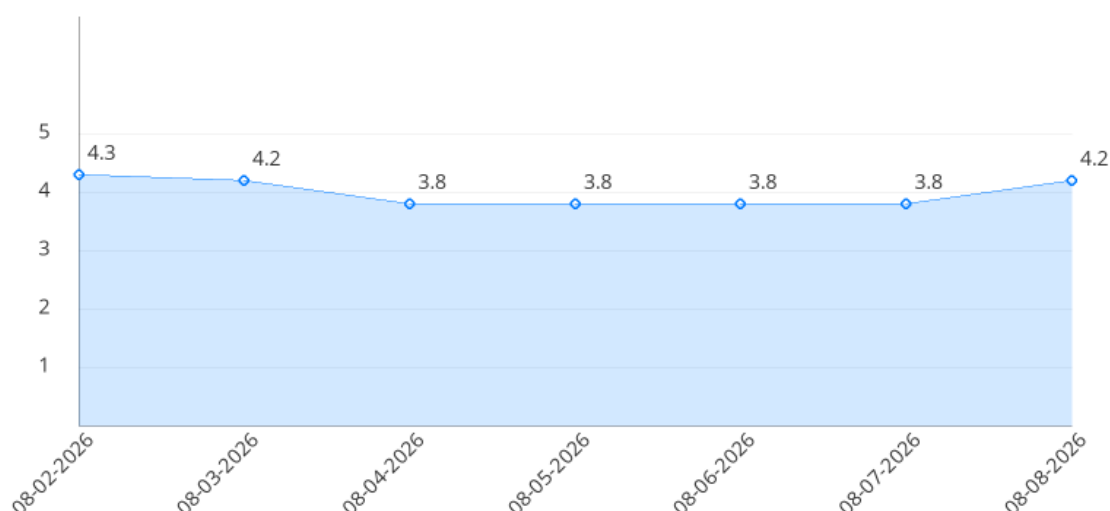

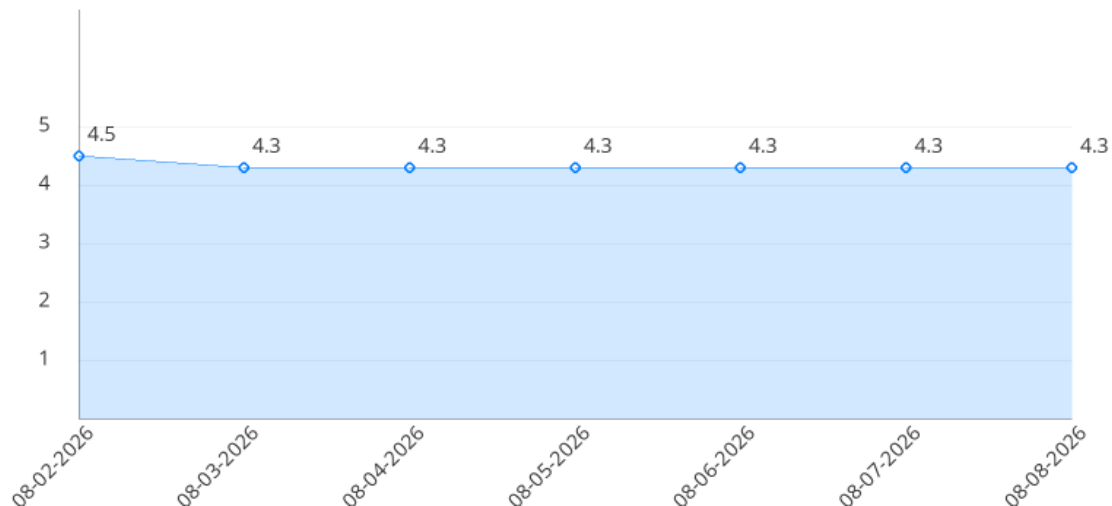

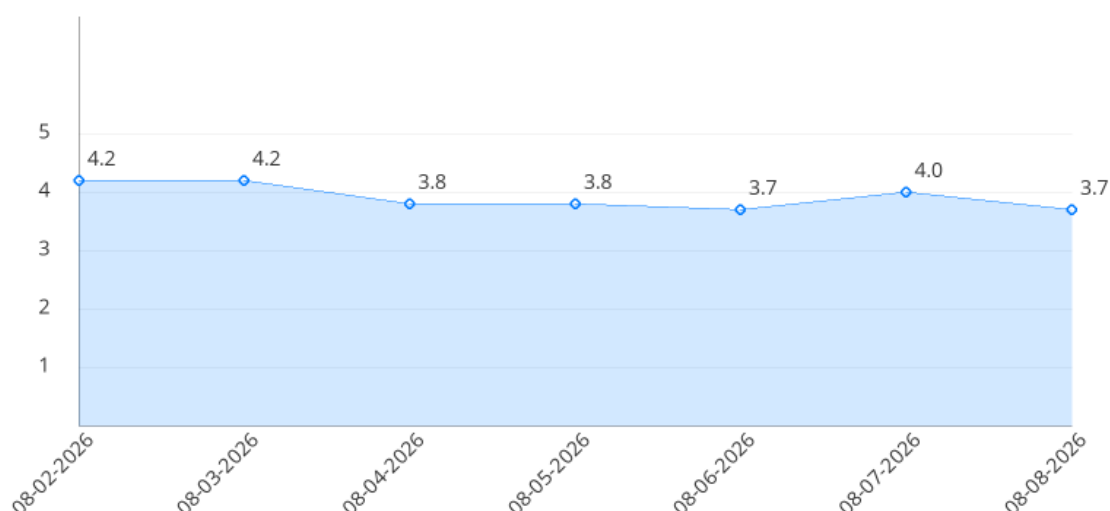

Score Trend (Week of August 2–8, 2026)



This week, the pandemic risk fluctuated between high and moderate levels, primarily due to ongoing outbreaks of Ebola, avian flu, and COVID-19. The situation is exacerbated by challenges in vaccine policy, public health response, and the spread of misinformation. Notably, there are also emerging concerns about other infectious diseases like MERS and Cyclospora. Efforts to contain these outbreaks are hindered by inadequate public health infrastructure and vaccine hesitancy. The need for enhanced surveillance, rapid response capabilities, and effective communication strategies remains critical to managing these threats.

- **[Industry]** Accelerate research and development of vaccines for emerging pathogens, utilizing advanced technologies like mRNA.
- **[Media]** Implement targeted campaigns to provide clear, evidence-based information on vaccines and disease prevention measures.

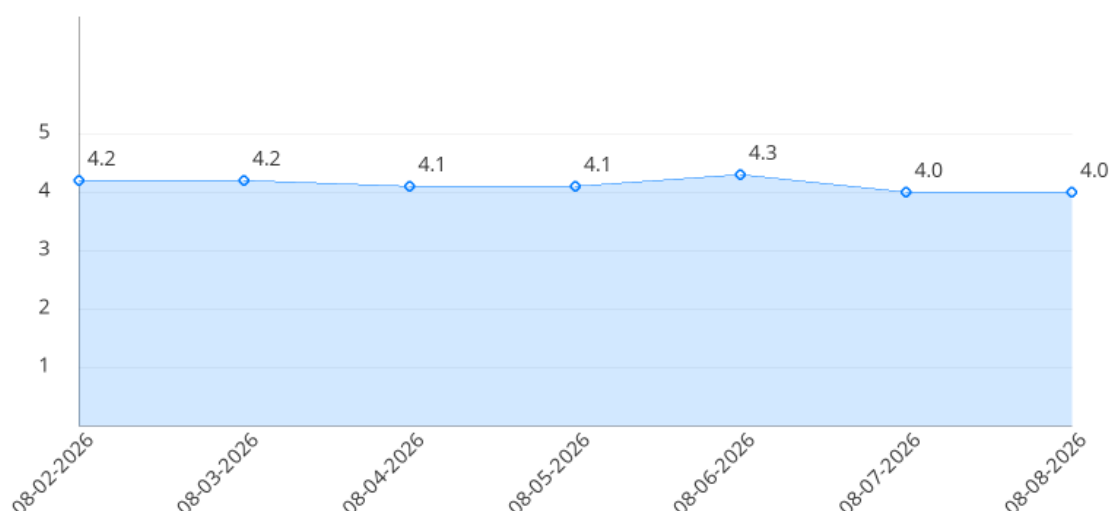

Social media platforms are struggling to contain the rapid spread of false information, which is further complicated by the emergence of AI-driven identity fraud and scams. The persistence of these issues highlights the need for enhanced detection tools and public education to mitigate the effects of misinformation. The global threat level underscores the urgency for collaborative efforts among governments, industries, and NGOs to address the challenges posed by misinformation.

Recommended Risk Reduction Actions

- **[Government]** Implement stricter regulations and verification processes for AI-generated content to prevent misuse and proliferation of misinformation.
- **[Industry]** Enhance algorithms and moderation practices to detect and limit the spread of misinformation and disinformation on digital platforms.
- **[NGO]** Increase public awareness campaigns to educate citizens on identifying and reporting misinformation, particularly in the context of elections and climate change.
- **[Education]** Integrate media literacy programs into school curriculums to equip students with critical thinking skills to discern credible information from falsehoods.
- **[International Organizations]** Strengthen international cooperation to track and dismantle disinformation networks, especially those linked to state actors.

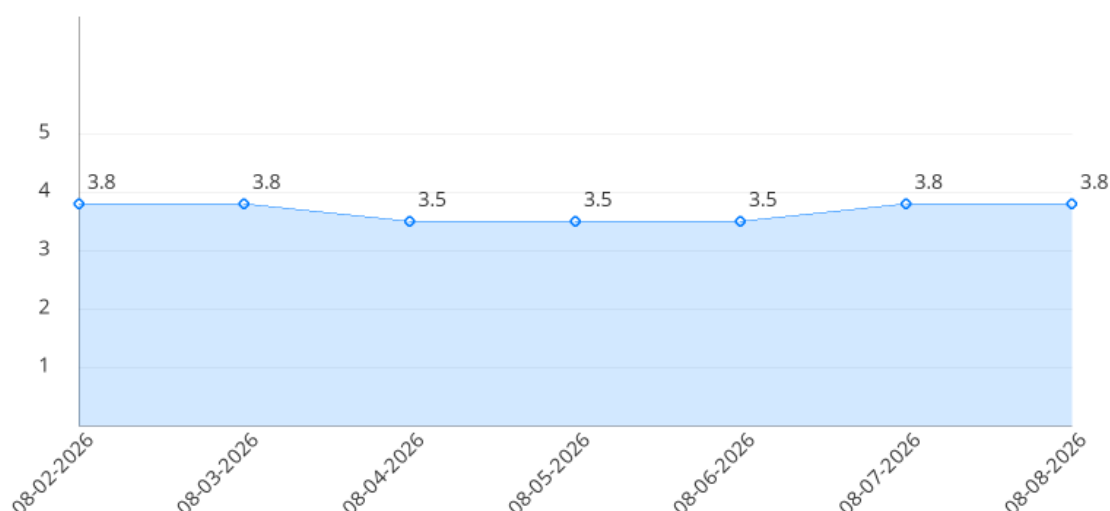

Unknown / Black Swan

Score Trend (Week of August 2–8, 2026)



This week, the emergence of rabies in Cape Fur Seals in South Africa has been highlighted as a significant unknown ecological and public health threat, with repeated mentions indicating its potential as a black swan event. This development has raised concerns about the transmission dynamics and potential for the disease to affect both marine and terrestrial ecosystems. Concurrently, destructive fires across Western Europe and smoke in Oregon have underscored the possibility of widespread environmental and health crises. Additionally, NASA's observation of a rocket part impacting the Moon has brought attention to the risks associated with space debris, while the deployment of Russian 'Starlink' over Ukraine poses novel threats to drone operations, potentially impacting geopolitical stability. These events emphasize the need for proactive measures to address unforeseen ecological, environmental, and technological risks.

Recommended Risk Reduction Actions

- **[Government]** Implement immediate wildlife health monitoring and containment measures in South Africa to prevent further spread of rabies among marine and terrestrial wildlife.
- **[Research Institutions]** Conduct urgent studies to understand the transmission pathways and ecological impacts of rabies in marine environments, and develop predictive models for similar outbreaks.
- **[Public Health Organizations]** Increase awareness and preparedness for potential rabies cases in humans, particularly in coastal communities, through education and preventive measures.
- **[International Bodies]** Facilitate cross-border collaboration to monitor and manage the spread of rabies and other wildlife diseases that have the potential to spread internationally.
- **[Space Agencies]** Increase funding for space debris tracking and mitigation technologies and collaborate internationally to establish guidelines for managing space debris and preventing unintended impacts.
