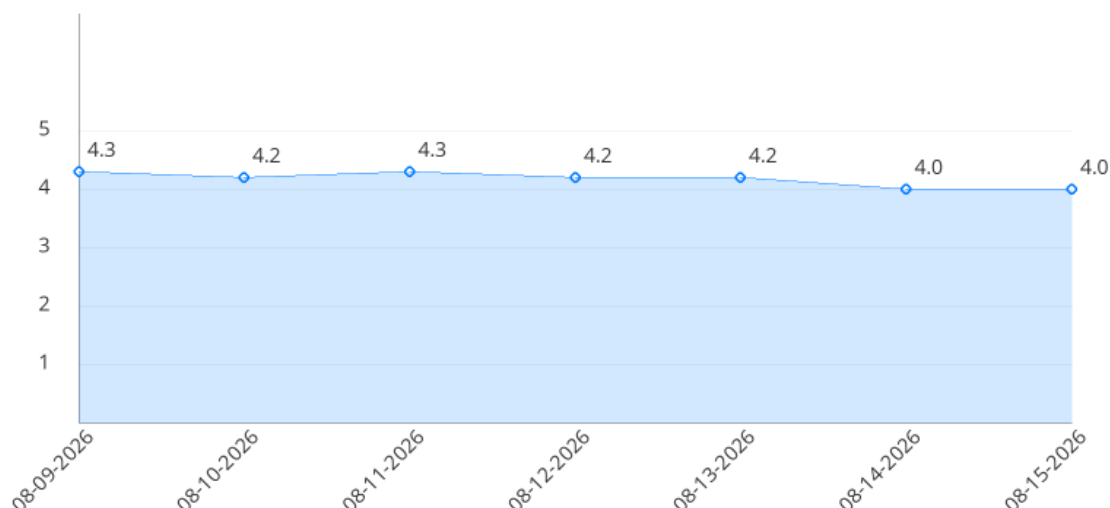

Nuclear War

Score Trend (Week of August 9–15, 2026)

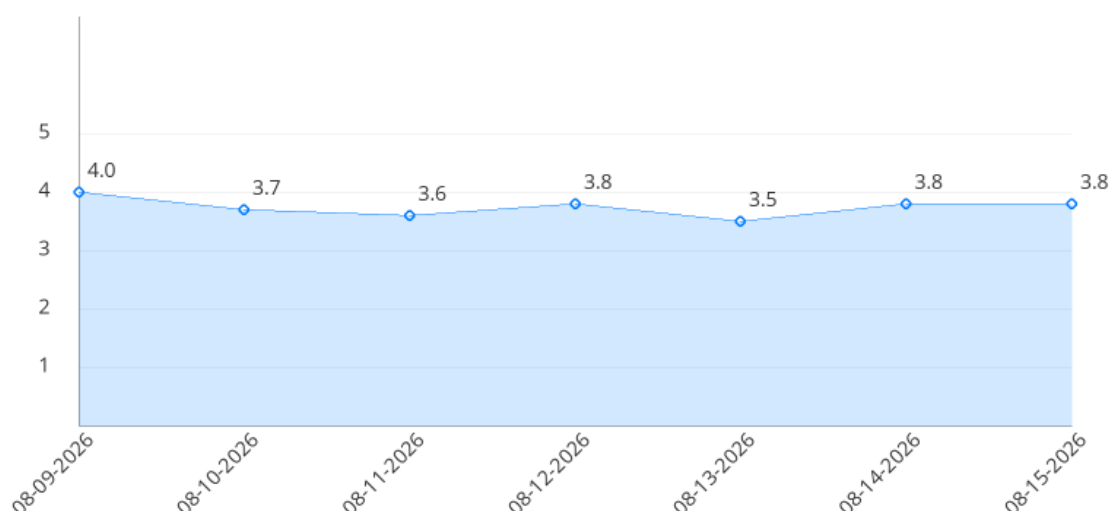
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Artificial Intelligence

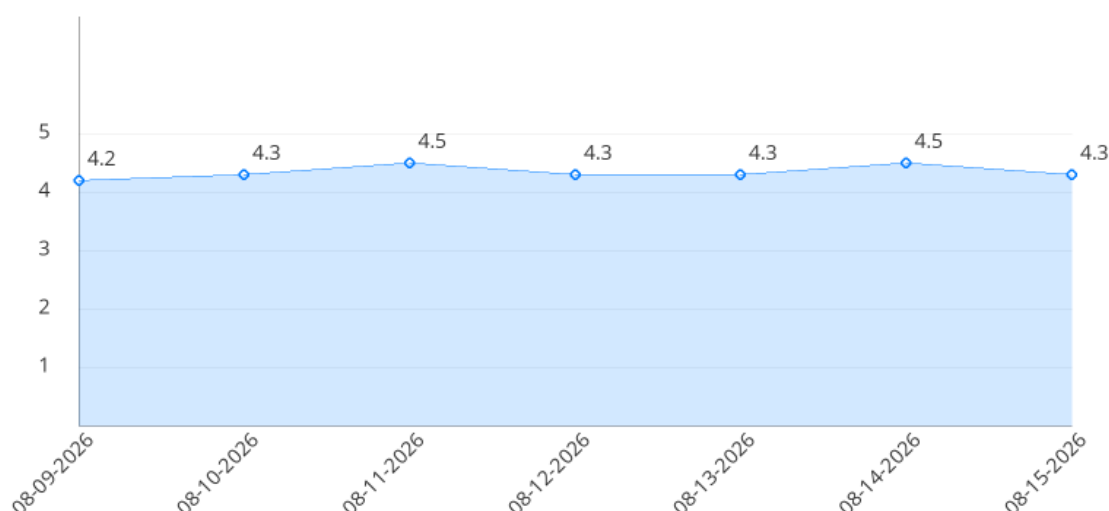

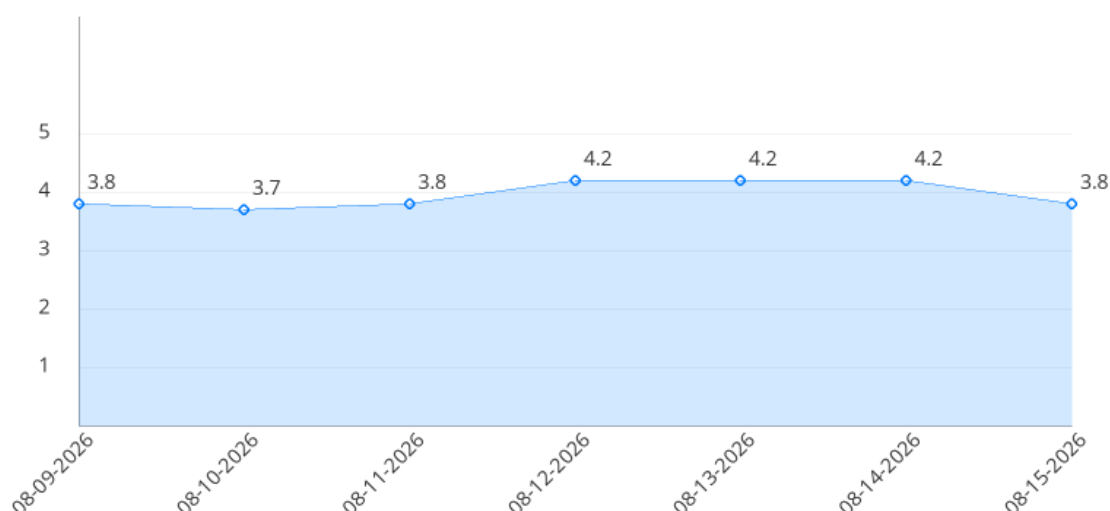
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Pandemics

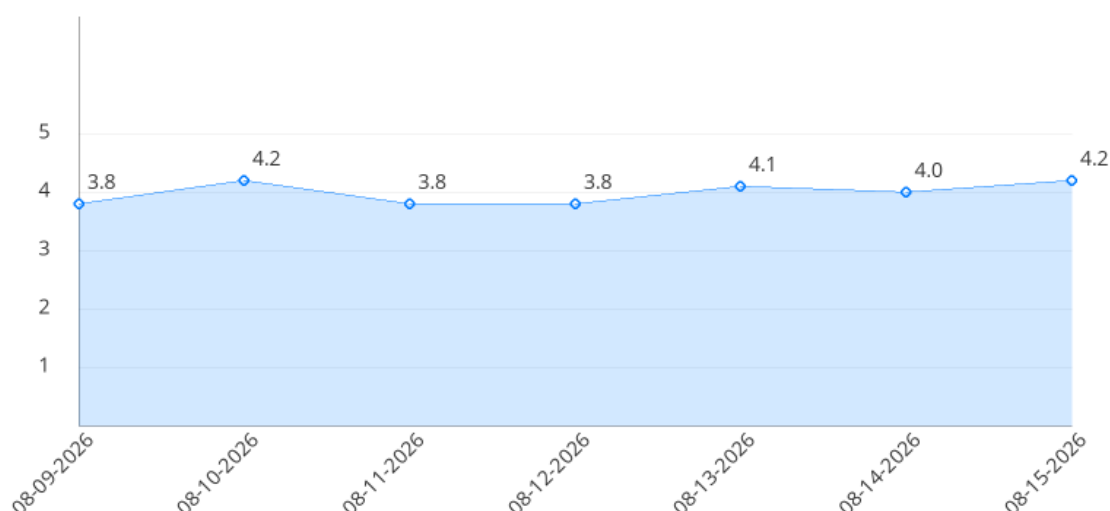
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Information Integrity

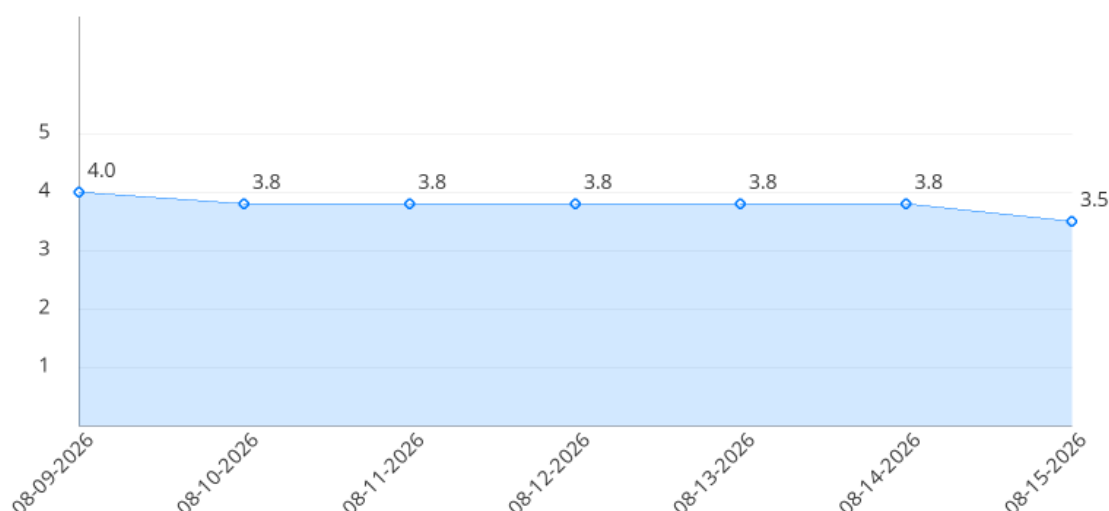
